ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED FEBRUARY 23, 2015:

ORD. NO. 34-2015 approving and authorizing the execution of a Development and Ground Lease Agreement with Steel Plate, LLC, or its designee, (“Redeveloper”), providing for the least of property with the option to purchase for redevelopment pursuant to the Massillon Road Industrial Park Redevelopment Plan; finding such property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

ORD. NO. 35-2015 authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to enter into an agreement for title, appraisal and review appraisal services to carry out the Community Development Program and other programs; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

ORD. NO. 36-2015 approving the sale of City-owned land on Columbia Avenue to Linda and George Simon; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

ORD. NO. 37-2015 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish dry storage at 1371 California Avenue. **VOTE: 11-0 (Swirsky did not vote)**

ORD. NO. 38-2015 approving, with modification, the renewal application of Amy and Robert Dunkler to have agricultural property at 1395 Collier Road placed in an “agricultural district” pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01, *et seq.*; and declaring an emergency. (D-166) (2/9/15) **VOTE: 12-0**

ORD. NO. 39-2015 approving the renewal application of Frank and Mary Politz to have agricultural property at 1661 Dreisbach Drive placed in an “agricultural district” pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01, *et seq.*; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

ORD. NO. 40-2015 accepting a dedication plat for Rosa Parks Drive, between South Broadway Street and South High Street; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

ORD. NO. 41-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the relocation of Johnston Street and the improvement and replacement of three expressway bridges; requesting the Director of Transportation to proceed with the project; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

RES. NO. 42-2015 expressing the sincere sympathy of the City of Akron to the family of Al Teodosio on the event of his passing and expressing appreciation for his many years of dedicated service to the community; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

RES. NO. 43-2015 expressing strong opposition to provisions in H.B. 53 that would prohibit cities from requiring contractors to employ a certain percentage of local residents; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**
