ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 13, 2015:

ORD. NO. 96-2015 approving the sale of City-owned land on North Howard Street to Oriana House, Inc.; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 97-2015 accepting property on Edgerton Road by donation for the C.D. Land Banking Project; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 98-2015 authorizing the purchase of various properties on West Emerling Avenue and South Main Street for the West Emerling Avenue Roadway Improvements Project; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 99-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Canal Construction Company for the construction and installation of a concrete barrier to protect the bridge piers for the Route 224 bridge over Ley Drive; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 100-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the Citywide Sidewalks 2015 Project; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 101-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids or requesting design-build proposals, for the construction of the Sewer Maintenance Yard Relocation project; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 102-2015 authorizing the Director of Law to enter into a contract with the Summit County Public Defender Commission to provide legal services for indigent defendants in Akron Municipal Court; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 103-2015 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with Oriana House, Inc., for confinement, rehabilitation services and alternative sentencing options for offenders convicted of Akron Code violations; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

RES. NO. 104-2015 urging the City of Akron and local entities and employers who do business with the City to reexamine and evaluate their hiring practices and provide training for returning citizens and misdemeanants; urging the Akron Civil Service Commission to re-examine and evaluate its Conviction Records Policy to determine whether it presents any undue obstacles with experts and community advocates to determine best practices and advise the Civil Service Commission on potential policy changes; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0 (Omobien absent)*

RES. NO. 105-2015 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in certain real property owned by Michael Piekarski, Trustee of the Michael Piekarski Revocable Living Trust UAD July 27, 2006, located on 647 E. Wilbeth Road, for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public, without charge, in conjunction with the Wilbeth Road Improvements Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of constructing,

reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0 (Omobien absent)***

RES. NO. 106-2015 opposing and objecting to the application of Grant Street Tavern, LLC, 1307 Grant Street, Akron, Ohio 44301 for a Class D1, D3 and D3A liquor permit (3327478) now pending before the Division of Liquor Control; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0 (Omobien absent)***
