ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 20, 2015:

ORD. NO. 107-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with the County of Summit for the City 2015 Construction Seal and Crack Filling program; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

ORD. NO. 108-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the Backwash Water Supply Upgrade for the Water Supply Plant; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

ORD. NO. 109-2015 authorizing the Mayor to apply for and enter into an agreement for a Violence Against Women Act grant administered by the Office of Criminal Justice Services; authorizing the Director of Law to enter into an agreement with Oriana House, Inc. to implement the grant by continuing to fund two police liaisons for the domestic violence unit and one police liaison for the misdemeanor unit; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

RES. NO. 110-2015 urging the citizens of Akron to vote “yes” on Issue 8, the Akron-Summit County Public Library levy, at the May 5, 2015 primary election, which is urgently needed to support the valuable and essential services that the Library offers to the greater Akron community, and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

RES. NO. 111-2015 expressing strong opposition to provisions in the House Budget Bill (HB 64) Amendment that would unfairly strip essential local government funding from communities, like the City of Akron, who lawfully operate photo speed enforcement programs in school zones, under their local Home Rule authority; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

RES. NO. 112-2015 expressing opposition to provisions in the House Budget Bill Amendment that would inhibit the ability of local governments to enter into project labor agreements (“PLA”), which are used to increase local hiring and streamline labor matters on construction projects; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***
