



CITY OF AKRON, OHIO

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 28, 2015:

ORD. NO. 281-2015 amending Ordinance No. 86-2015, passed March 30, 2015, which established the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2015 and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 282-2015 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Metro Regional Transit Authority (“Metro”) for the sale of City-owned property on East Bartges Street and the acquisition of property owned by Metro on Furnace Street; authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement for the lease and sale of the property to be acquired on Furnace Street to Testa Enterprises and Concord Testa Hotel Associates (the “Redevelopers”) for public and private parking; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 283-2015 approving the sale of 0.36 acres of City-owned land located at 752 Blaine Avenue to Urban Vision, determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 284-2015 authorizing the Mayor to participate in the Water Resource Restoration Sponsor Program and to enter into Sponsorship Agreements with the Nature Conservancy for the Kitty Todd Preserve Wetland Additions project, with the City of Columbus for the proposed Clover Groff/Hellbranch Stream Restoration Project, and with the Western Reserve Land Conservancy for the proposed Silver Creek Wetlands and Tributaries Project; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 285-2015 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with H.M. Miller Construction Co. for the emergency repair of the 72 inch storm sewer at 1200 Firestone Boulevard; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 286-2015 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct signage at 1290 West Market Street and at 1375 West Exchange Street; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 287-2015 amending the Zoning Map by changing the Apartment House Use District Classification (U2, H2, A3) on property on the east side of North Howard Street, south of East Cuyahoga Falls Avenue, to a Retail Business Use District Classification (U3, H1, A1); and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 288-2015 authorizing a Conditional Use to place oversized signage at 2620 Ridgewood Road; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 289-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to execute an oil and/or gas lease agreement for the mineral rights of approximately 11.73 acres of City-owned land and street rights-of-way for completion of the “Luck Unit No. 1” gas/oil well drilling unitization on the east side of 25th Street S.W., north of U.S. 224; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 9-2 (Williams & Mosley-Samples voted no)**

ORD. NO. 290-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to execute, on behalf of the City, an oil and/or gas lease agreement for the mineral rights of approximately 2.92 acres of City-owned land and street rights-of-way for completion of the “Carpenter Unit No. 1” gas/oil well drilling unitization at 1023 West Waterloo Road; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 9-2 (Williams & Mosley-Samples voted no)**

ORD. NO. 291-2015 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into a grant agreement with the State of Ohio for funding from the 2015 Body-Worn Camera Pilot Implementation Program; authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement to implement the grant; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

RES. NO. 292-2015 approving and confirming the appointments of Nicholas Fernandez and Robert DeJournette to the Metro Regional Transit Authority Board of Trustees; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

RES. NO. 293-2015 expressing the sincere sympathy of the City of Akron to the family and loved ones of Akron Police Officer and FOP President Paul Hlynsky on the occasion of his passing; expressing appreciation for his many years of service, advocacy, and leadership; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**
