



# CITY OF AKRON, OHIO

## ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 5, 2015:

**ORD. NO. 294-2015** authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a telecommunications tower on the south side of Clifford Avenue, west of Inman Street; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

**ORD. NO. 295-2015** approving the recommendations of the Tax Incentive Review Councils regarding the continuation, modification and or/cancellation of tax increment financing agreements in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

**ORD. NO. 296-2015** approving the donation of 987 Indian Trail and 1045 Nome Avenue to Nazareth Housing Development Corporation; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

**ORD. NO. 297-2015** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for street tree trimming services; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

**ORD. NO. 298-2015** approving and authorizing the execution of a Purchase and Sale Agreement with CMD Copley, LLC, or its assignee providing for the sale and redevelopment of property pursuant to the Copley Road East Neighborhood Business District Renewal Area Plan, as amended; finding such property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

**ORD. NO. 299-2015** authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$30,000,000, for the purpose of retiring a portion of the outstanding Certificates of Participation, Series 2005-A (Project Facilities Project) and Certificates of Participation, Series 2007 (Parking Facilities Project) previously issued to pay costs of parking facilities in the City; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

**ORD. NO. 300-2015** authorizing the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$15,000,000 Taxable Economic Development Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2015, of the City of Akron under Section 13 of Article VIII of the Constitution of the State of Ohio and Chapter 165 of the Ohio Revised Code for the purpose of refunding notes and bonds previously issued by the City to assist in financing a portion of the costs of a "project" as defined in Section 165.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, for the purpose of creating or preserving jobs and employment opportunities and improving the economic welfare of the people of the City and of the State of Ohio, authorizing the signing of a supplemental trust indenture, establishing certain funds of the City pursuant thereto; authorizing the signing of a bond purchase agreement, and other documents in connection with the issuance and sale of the Series 2015 Bonds; authorizing the signing and distribution of a preliminary and final official statement; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

**ORD. NO. 301-2015** determining to proceed with the improvement of Main Street between the termini of Miller Avenue and Bartges Street and Broadway Street between the termini of Miller Avenue and Bartges Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; installing street lighting and roof drain pipes; and planting trees; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0**

**RES. NO. 302-2015** expressing the sincere sympathy and heartfelt condolences of the City of Akron to the families and loved ones of the persons killed in the attack on Umpqua Community College in Oregon; condemning the senseless act of violence that took the lives of nine innocent victims and injured many others; and urging Congressional leaders to adopt meaningful, common sense gun control measures that will reduce gun deaths while respecting the rights of responsible gun owners; and declaring an emergency.
