



CITY OF AKRON, OHIO

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 26, 2015:

RES. NO. 322-2015 requesting that the Summit County Fiscal Officer make an advanced payment of tax funds for tax year 2015 payable in 2016 to the City of Akron Treasury Division; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 323-2015 accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission of Summit County and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the Summit County Fiscal Officer; and declared an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 324-2015 authorizing the issuance of a bond of the City in a principal amount not to exceed \$50,000,000 for sale to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund of the State of Ohio to finance the costs of improvements to the City's wastewater system; pledging certain revenues from the City's wastewater system on a subordinated basis to secure the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bond; and authorizing the execution and delivery of the Bond, the Trust Agreement and other documents and the taking of other actions related to the issuance and sale of the Bond, and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 325-2015 authorizing the Director of Finance to enter into an agreement with The University of Akron School of Law to provide an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for its expungement program; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 326-2015 approving the sale of various parcels of City-owned land; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 327-2015 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Interval Brotherhood Home to provide comprehensive residential drug and alcohol treatment to eligible individuals; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 328-2015 approving and confirming the appointments of Councilman Donnie Kammer and Barbara Brown to the Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 329-2015 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract, following a competitive quotation process, for the purchase of new duty handguns for the Akron Police Division; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 330-2015 appointing Councilman Richard Swirsky and Councilwoman Tara Mosley-Samples to the Akron-Bath-Copley Joint Township Hospital District Board; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 331-2015 urging Akron citizens to vote "No" on Ohio Issue 3, which would give certain, wealthy investors permanent, exclusive rights to grow, process, and distribute marijuana in Ohio, without direct accountability to the voters of Ohio; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 332-2015 urging Akron citizens to vote “Yes” on Ohio Issue 1, which will create a bi-partisan redistricting commission to approve General Assembly districts and implement safeguards to prevent partisan gerrymandering; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 333-2015 urging Akron citizens to vote “Yes” on Ohio Issue 21, in order to create a nonpartisan Council Districting Commission to apportion fair County Council districts commencing with the 2020 federal census; and urging Akron voters to vote “No” on Issue 22, a measure that would redraw current County Council districts in a way that would favor Republicans, weaken the potential for minority representation, and dilute Akron’s importance on County Council; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**
