ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED FEBRUARY 1, 2016:

ORD. NO. 18-2016 approving the sale of a portion of City-owned land located at 492 Koerber Ave. to David Swain, determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 19-2016 authorizing the purchase of 212 Mustill Ct., 137 Otto St. and 155 Otto St. for the Ohio Canal Interceptor Tunnel Project; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 20-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the East Market Street Redevelopment project, to improve the roadway, enhance pedestrian and vehicular safety, and utilize complete streets design in the area surrounding the old Goodyear Headquarters; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 21-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the microresurfacing of U.S. Route 224, between the I-277 and Kelly Avenue exits; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

ORD. NO. 22-2016 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with The K Company for the emergency replacement of three HVAC units at Kenmore Community Center; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 23-2016 amending Resolution No. 53-2012, as amended, to revise and supplement Rule 2.8 of the "Rules of Procedure for Akron City Council," to update the duties of the President and Vice President of Council; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 7-6 (Kilby, Milkovich, Mosley-Samples, Neal, Omobien, and Sims voted No)**

RES. NO. 24-2016 expressing support for the application of the East Akron Neighborhood Development Corporation and American Community Developers, Inc. for the Spring Hill Apartments - Phase III Tax Credit Development to rehabilitate a development of affordable apartment units in the City; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 13-0**

RES. NO. 25-2016 expressing support for the application of the Mason Intergenerational Housing for the Mason Intergenerational Housing Tax Credit Development, in order to build a development of affordable apartment units in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

ORD. NO. 26-2016 approving and authorizing the execution of an option agreement and a development agreement with East Akron Neighborhood Development Corporation or its designee, providing for the sale or lease and redevelopment of City-owned property; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 12-0 (Neal abstained)**
