ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 28, 2016

ORD. NO. 82-2016 to make the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2016; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 83-2016 approving the sale of City-owned land on Ido Avenue to Theresa Behrens in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the land and to reduce the City's costs in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 84-2016 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Liberta Construction for the emergency construction of the Fairlawn Heights Storm Outfall #328 Reconstruction project; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 85-2016 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Canal Construction Company for the emergency construction of the tie-in of the lateral sanitary sewer at 56 Royal Place; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 86-2016 ratifying the actions of the Purchasing Agent in entering into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Jones Chemical, Inc. for the purchase of sodium hydroxide needed for the Water Supply Plant; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 87-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to submit an application and enter into an agreement with the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority for a Community Recycling Access Grant, in furtherance with Mayor Horrigan's objectives of supporting new and existing community recycling projects which would sustain and increase recycling activities within Summit County; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 88-2016 authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a vehicle storage lot at 1016 Neville Avenue; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 89-2016 authorizing the Director of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into a contract with the Northeast Ohio Basketball Association for the management, promotion and operation of the King James Shooting Stars Classic and the Lady James Queens Classic Basketball events, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of supporting healthy recreational activities for area youth and promoting the greater Akron area by stimulating the local economy with millions of dollars in revenue for local businesses; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*
