ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 18, 2016:

ORD. NO. 108-2016 accepting various right-of-way documents for 788 Evans Avenue to facilitate the completion of the SUM Evans Avenue Project; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 109-2016 approving the sale of various parcels of vacant City-owned land pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of activating underutilized spaces for the benefit of the community, and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 110-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the Street Tree Replacement 2016 Program, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of replacing trees removed due to age, disease, or accidents and to beautify and improve the environment of our Akron neighborhoods; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 111-2016 authorizing the Mayor or the Director of Public Service to file an application and enter into an agreement with the Ohio Water Development Authority for a loan to finance the construction of the Carpenter Sewer Separation Project (CSO Rack 30) Project; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 112-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the Exchange Cedar Steam Condensate Project, which will install new steam and condensate lines, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of reducing the amount of water flow entering the combined sewers and providing needed service to our local hospitals; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 113-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service, in connection with the construction of the CSO Rack 30 Storage Basin or the Carpenter Sewer Separation, to enter into construction contracts, including Construction Manager at Risk and Design Build agreements, after publicly advertising for bids or obtaining qualifications and proposals; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 114-2016 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Life Technologies Corporation for the purchase of QuanticoStudio 5 96well 0.2ml Block Real-Time PCR System advanced testing equipment for use by the Water Supply Bureau, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's efforts to advance public health and enhance reservoir management by optimizing options to reduce the potential for cyanobacteria (bluegreen algae) contamination in the City's raw water source and ensure continued compliance with Ohio EPA mandates; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

ORD. NO. 115-2016 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Itron, Inc. for the testing, repair, and replacement of existing handheld water meter reading field collector units used by the Water Distribution Division, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objective of providing accurate and reliable customer service to Akron's water customers; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

ORD. NO. 116-2016 amending and/or supplementing Title 7 "Traffic," Chapter 76 "Parking Regulations," Section 76.31 "Off-street parking" to forbid parking on vacant residential lots and to authorize the Department of Neighborhood Assistance to enforce regulations regarding illegal off-street parking; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

ORD. NO. 117-2016 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement with the Department of Homeland Security for funding for 25 firefighters from the Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) Grant Program; authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement to implement this grant, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of seeking out all reasonable and available funding sources to supplement local funds and to enhance the City's ability to provide for the safety and welfare of the Akron community; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

ORD. NO. 118-2016 approving and confirming the appointment of Laneita Jones to the Housing Appeals Board for term ending April 1, 2019, in order to advance the functions of the Housing Appeals Board in reducing blight and increasing the upkeep and quality of housing in our neighborhoods; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

ORD. NO. 119-2016 accepting a vacation plat for a portion of former Emmitt Road, on the south side of East Waterloo Road, east of George Washington Boulevard, in order to allow for the development of a GetGo fuel station, café, market, and car wash at 1900 East Waterloo Road; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

ORD. NO. 120-2016 accepting a vacation and rededication plat as utility right-of way for Cook Street between Goodyear Boulevard and East Market Street, and for Mary Avenue between Cook Street and Kelly Avenue in order to allow for additional retail development in the East End redevelopment area; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

ORD. NO. 121-2016 approving the sale of .08 acres of City-owned land at the northeast corner of the intersection of East South Street and Allyn Street to Christ is the Answer Ministries, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the land as additional parking; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

ORD. NO. 122-2016 approving and authorizing the execution of a Lease Agreement with the Akron Children's Museum or its designee for space located on the ground floor of the O'Neil's parking deck, in order to facilitate the development of a new interactive museum for children in the Akron area, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's goals of providing affordable family-friendly attractions for residents, creating new and high quality educational and recreational opportunities for Akron youth, and encouraging thoughtful development in Downtown Akron in order to create and preserve job opportunities; finding such property is not needed for any public use; and related findings; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

ORD. NO. 123-2016 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement for funding from the 2016 Summit County Emergency Management Agency Grant to purchase and equip a trailer to store and transport Mobile Field Force equipment for the Akron Police Division; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***
