ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 25, 2016:

ORD. NO. 124-2016 declaring the necessity of, determining to proceed with, and levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets in the City by constructing, reconstructing and repairing concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, curbs and retaining walls and installing roof drain pipes; all in accordance with petitions submitted by property owners under the 2015 City-Wide Sidewalk Program; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 125-2016 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into an agreement or agreements with local agencies to carry out the Emergency Solutions Grant Program for program year 2016, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's efforts to support local organizations that provide emergency and transitional shelter and supportive services to homeless individuals and families and prevent homelessness through rapid rehousing, relocation, and stabilization services; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 126-2016 levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini (2015 Phase I Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 127-2016 levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini (2015 Phase I Arterial/Collector Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 128-2016 levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini (2015 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 129-2016 declaring the necessity of, determining to proceed with, and levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets in the City by constructing, reconstructing and repairing concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, curbs and retaining walls and installing roof drain pipes; all in accordance with petitions submitted by property owners under the 2014 City-Wide Sidewalk Program; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

RES. NO. 130-2016 urging the United States Senate to fulfill its obligation under the Constitution of the United States to conduct confirmation hearings and provide full and fair consideration of President Obama's nominee for Associate Justice of the United States Supreme Court, to confirm any qualified nominee and appoint such qualified nominee to fill the vacancy on the United States Supreme Court, in accordance with Article II of the United States Constitution; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*
