ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 2, 2016:

ORD. NO. 131-2016 authorizing the issuance of a bond of the City in a principal amount not to exceed \$72,500,000 for sale to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund of the State of Ohio to finance the costs of improvements to the City's wastewater system; pledging certain revenues from the City's wastewater system on a subordinated basis to secure the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bond; and authorizing the execution and delivery of the Bond, the Trust Agreement and other documents and the taking of other actions related to the issuance and sale of the Bond, and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 132-2016 declaring the necessity of, determining to proceed with, and levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets in the City by constructing, reconstructing and repairing concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, curbs and retaining walls and installing roof drain pipes; all in accordance with petitions submitted by property owners under the 2013 City-Wide Sidewalk Program; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 133-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the White Pond Parkway Sewer Extension project, to eliminate the need for and the cost of constructing a pump station at the White Pond Office Park; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 134-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service, in connection with the construction of the Water Reclamation Facility Treatment Plant Expansion, to enter into construction contracts, including Construction Manager at Risk and Design Build agreements, after publicly advertising for bids or obtaining qualifications and proposals; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 135-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the completion of the 1624 Englewood Avenue Building Demolition project; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

RES. NO. 136-2016 opposing and objecting to the application of Dolgen Midwest, LLC, DBA Dollar General Store 16599, 705 S. Arlington Street, Akron, Ohio 44306 for a Class C1, C2 liquor permit (22348152170) now pending before the Division of Liquor Control; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 137-2016 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct the Ellet Community Learning Center at 309 Woolf Avenue; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 138-2016 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a mutual aid agreement with the City of Cleveland regarding matters involving law enforcement, pursuant to Section 2 of the Charter of the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

RES. NO. 139-2016 adopting a Health in All Policies approach for the City of Akron that takes into account the complex environmental and social factors that contribute to poor health and health inequity in our communities, and systematically considers the short- and long-term health implications of policy decisions in order to improve health equity and health outcomes for all citizens of Akron; encouraging businesses, community leaders, and public officials at all levels of government to join in this Health in All Policies approach to policy and decision-making; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***
