## **ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 3, 2016:**

**RES. NO. 300-2016** declaring it necessary to improve Aqueduct Street between the termini of West Market Street and Memorial Parkway by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; and installing roof drain pipes; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

**ORD. NO. 301-2016** authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement with the Ohio Water Development Authority for a loan to finance the construction of the Aqueduct Street Green Improvements Project; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

**ORD. NO. 302-2016** authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for a replacement boiler for the South Blower Building at the Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

**ORD. NO. 303-2016** authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the reconditioning of four high service pump motors at the Water Supply Plant; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

**ORD. NO. 304-2016** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the Heintz Hillcrest Park Trail, which will include the construction of a walking trail and the installation of basic outdoor fitness facilities in the area surrounding the tennis courts at the Park; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

**ORD. NO. 305-2016** providing for the issuance and sale of bonds of the City in a maximum principal amount of \$30,000,000 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, renovating, repairing, enlarging, adding to, reconstructing, maintaining, equipping, furnishing, acquiring interests in real property in connection with, improving the sites of, and otherwise improving, Community Learning Centers, and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 11-1 (Neal)***

**ORD. NO. 306-2016** authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a three-unit apartment house at 2049-2051 Quayle Drive; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

**ORD. NO. 307-2016** authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an oversized garage at 709 Brewer Avenue; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

**ORD. NO. 308-2016** authorizing a Conditional Use to establish motor vehicle sales on the east side of Home Avenue, north of Annapolis Avenue; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

**ORD. NO. 309-2016** authorizing the Director of Public Service to grant an easement on City-owned property to provide access to Crown Castle to install fiber optic cable in the area of Johnston and Spicer Streets; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

**ORD. NO. 310-2016** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a lease on City-owned property to provide access to Crown Castle to install fiber optic cable under the Kenmore Boulevard Bridge. ***VOTE: 12-0***

**ORD. NO. 311-2016** authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$8,000,000, for the purpose of refunding certain maturities of general obligation bonds of the City issued in 2010; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

**ORD. NO. 312-2016** authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$11,000,000, for the purpose of refunding certain maturities of general obligation bonds of the City issued in 2009; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

**ORD. NO. 313-2016** providing for the issuance and sale of bonds of the City in a maximum principal amount of \$17,335,000 for the purpose of refunding bonds issued by the City in 2010 to pay the costs of acquiring, constructing, improving, renovating, repairing, enlarging, adding to, reconstructing, maintaining, equipping, furnishing, acquiring interests in real property in connection with, improving the sites of, and otherwise improving, Community Learning Centers, and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

**ORD. NO. 314-2016** authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$25,765,000, for the purpose of refunding certain maturities of income tax revenue bonds of the City issued in 2012; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

**ORD. NO. 315-2016** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract without the formality of advertising for bids, with Bain Enterprises for the Purchase of a trailer-mounted vacuum/valve turning machine; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***
