ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED NOVEMBER 28, 2016:

ORD. NO 376-2016 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract or contracts after publicly advertising for bids through the Office of the Purchasing Agent for the improvement of office space in the laboratory at the Water Reclamation Facility; approving the specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 377-2016 providing for the temporary appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the period of January 1, 2017 through March 31, 2017; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 378-2016 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Cadre Computer Resources Co., for firewall hardware and software upgrades, including CheckPoint firewall hardware and software, to better protect the City of Akron from new malicious attacks through email and the Internet; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 379-2016 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with the United States Department of Transportation for the Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) grant program funding for the construction of improvements in the Main Street Corridor; authorizing the expenditure of local funds, in support of the grant in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of encouraging catalytic development Downtown and investing in a walkable, bikeable, livable Main Street; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 380-2016 authorizing the Mayor to execute a relocation grant agreement with Gabriel Performance Products, LLC, to support job creation in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 381-2016 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the County of Summit, Ohio, (the "County") in order to utilize the County's Office of Information Technology, for information systems technology and data processing support services, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of encouraging fair and effective intergovernmental cooperation and collaboration for the benefit of the Akron community; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***
