ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 8, 2017:

ORD 136 – 2017 approving the sale of various vacant parcels of City-owned land pursuant to the City’s “A Lot for A Little” Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 137-2017 authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase of miscellaneous traffic items including sign blanks, sign brackets and street signs and posts; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 138-2017 authorizing the Director of Public Service to inspect and/or approve the construction of certain private sewer improvements on or around Vernon Odom Boulevard; approving the plans, profiles and/or specifications related thereto; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 139-2017 authorizing a Conditional Use to convert a detached garage into a dwelling at 424-426 Butler Avenue; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 140-2017 authorizing the issuance of a bond of the City in a principal amount not to exceed \$23,000,000 for sale to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund of the State of Ohio to finance costs of improvements to the City’s wastewater system; pledging certain revenues from the City’s wastewater system on a subordinated basis to secure the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bond; and authorizing the execution and delivery of the Bond, the Trust Agreement and other documents and the taking of other actions related to the issuance and sale of the Bond; repealing Ordinance No. 112-2017 passed by this Council on April 17, 2017 in its entirety; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 141-2017 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter in a contract or contracts providing for the replacement of the roof on the structure located at 800 Dan Street; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

RES 142-2017 approving and confirming the reappointment of Jack Hefner to the Metro Regional Transit Authority (“Metro”) Board of Trustees for term ending February 28, 2020; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**
