ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 15, 2017:

ORD.143-2017 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay \$60,000 to support the planning and implementation of the 2017 Akron International Soap Box Derby; and declaring an emergency. **Vote 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

ORD.144-2017 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay \$15,000 for an operating subsidy to Cascade Locks Park Association, in order to support the maintenance of the Cascade Locks and Mustill Store Museum as a welcoming recreational and culturally educational urban green space; and declaring an emergency. **Vote 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

ORD.145-2017 authorizing the sale of City-owned property: determining that the said property is not needed for a public use; and declaring an emergency. **Vote 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

ORD.146-2017 approving the sale of various parcels of vacant City-owned land pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program; determining said property in not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **Vote 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

ORD.147-2017 approving the donation of City-owned land located at 587 Lovers Lane to the Summit County Land Bank, determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **Vote 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

ORD.148-2017 approving the donation of various City-owned properties; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **Vote 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

RES. 149-2017 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2017 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface, and declaring an emergency. **Vote 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

RES. 150-2017 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2017) Phase I Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency. **Vote 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

RES. 151-2017 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2017 Phase I Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency. **Vote 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

ORD. 152-2017 amending Title 15, Chapter 150 of the code of Ordinances of the City of Akron to amend/supplement Section 150.08 "Equipment and facilities," Section 150.13 "Rooming houses –

Equipment and facilities, “ and Section 150.99 “Penalties,” and declaring an emergency. **Vote 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

RES. 153-2017 approving amendments to the Articles of Incorporation of the Akron Energy Special Improvement District; and declaring an emergency. **Vote 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

ORD. 154-2017 authorizing the Mayor to accept the grant from the Summit county Landbank for the demolition of the Firestone Clubhouse; authorizing the expenditure of matching funds; and declaring an emergency. **Vote 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

ORD. 155-2017 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into contracts with non-profit neighborhood-based organizations for the provision of services, including, among other things, neighborhood events, community gardens and beautification projects and after school and mentoring programs; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. **Vote 12-0 (Neal abstained)**

ORD. 156-2017 amending/supplementing Title 9 “General Provisions,” Chapter 98 “Streets and Sidewalks” to enact Article 9 “Complete, Livable and Green Streets Advisory Commission” to establish an advisory Commission to create a Complete, Livable and Green Streets Plan to aid the City of Akron personnel in the development, implementation, and future use of complete, livable and green streets in future City of Akron construction projects within the public right-of-way; and declaring an emergency. **(Substitute Offered as an Amendment) Vote 13-0**

ORD. 157-2017 authorizing the Mayor, in furtherance of the City’s efforts to combat violent crimes against women and to provide services to victims of violent crimes, to apply for and enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services, for 2017 grant funds through the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) Subgrant program; to accept and enter into an agreement for 2016 funds previously awarded; and declaring an emergency. **Vote 13-0**
