***New Legislation List-June 5, 2017***

**BUDGET & FINANCE:**

1. Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Engaged Public for the purchase of one-year subscriptions to Balancing Act PRO, Taxpayer Receipt, and Meeting Mode software services; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC SERVICE:**

2. Ordinance declaring the necessity of, determining to proceed with, and levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets in the City by constructing, reconstructing and repairing concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, curbs and retaining walls and installing roof drain pipes; all in accordance with petitions submitted by property owners under the 2016 City-Wide Sidewalk Program; and declaring an emergency.

3. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service, after publicly advertising for bids through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract or contracts for the construction of improvements for the Safe Routes to School 2015 program; and declaring an emergency.

3A. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an emergency contract with Cardinal Environmental for the reconstruction of the Civic Theater building wall adjacent to where the former Stage Left building stood; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC UTILITIES:**

4. Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of a replacement gate actuator for the Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency.

5. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Finance to reimburse the County of Summit for the costs of construction to relocate a water main in Arlington Road in the vicinity of Warner Road as part of an overall roadway improvement project; and declaring an emergency.

**PARKS & RECREATION:**

6. Ordinance authorizing the Director of the Department of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into a contract with the Catholic Charities Community Services Corporation for the operation of the summer recreation program for youth with disabilities, in order to support this successful and valuable program for the benefit of the disabled youth in our community; and declaring an emergency.

7. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service through the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the lease/rental of a mobile LED screen; and declaring an emergency. *(Substitute Offered as an Amendment)*

**GREEN/SUSTAINABILITY:**

8. Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement or agreements for the Community Recreation Project – Pass Through Grant Agreement from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the portion of the remedial design for the management of Gorge Dam contaminated sediments to facilitate the removal of the Gorge Dam; and declaring an emergency.

9. Resolution urging the General Assembly and Governor John Kasich to take the steps necessary to amend HB 49 to grant the 1545 park districts in the State of Ohio the same protections as the state parks and nature preserves when it comes to being placed in natural gas or oil units; and declaring an emergency.

**MISCELLANEOUS:**

10. Resolution expressing opposition to the proposed federal budget put forth by President Trump and urging President Trump, members of Congress, and other policy makers in Washington to pass a fiscally responsible budget that does not hurt the most vulnerable among us and that invests in the future of our nation; and declaring an emergency.
