ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 5, 2017:

ORD 172-2017 approving the sale of a vacant City-owned property pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 173-2017 authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the Land Acquisition Agent, to purchase the real property located at 1044 Hazel Street, Akron, Ohio for the CSO Rack 10/11 Storage Basin Project; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 174-2017 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and grant an easement on City-owned property near Triplett Boulevard and Lansing Road to The East Ohio Gas Company dba Dominion East Ohio; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 175-2017 authorizing the Director of Public Service to apply for and enter into a grant agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") for the repair/replacement of pavement areas and markings at the Akron Fulton Airport; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 176-2017 authorizing the Director of Public Service to apply for and enter into a grant agreement with the Ohio Water Development Authority ("OWDA") for a research and development grant aimed at exploring the potential use of water treatment byproduct in preventing harmful algal blooms; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 177-2017 authorizing the Director of Public Service through the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Norris Brothers Co., Inc., for the removal and replacement of four (4) vertical turbine pump sole plates located at the Akron Water Plant, 1570 Ravenna Road, Kent, Ohio (the "Water Plant"); and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 178-2017 repealing Title 11 “Business Regulations,” Chapter 111 “Regulations Governing Specific Businesses,” Article 20 “Movers and Moving Companies,” in order to align with current standard practices; amending Title 11 “Business Regulations,” Chapter 111 “Regulations Governing Specific Businesses,” Article 37 “Petting Zoos,” Section 111.999 “Penalty”; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 179-2017 amending Ordinance 63-2017, which re-authorized the My Neighborhood Our Akron City Council Grant Agreement Program for the year 2017; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 180-2017 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a detached garage at 1885 6th Street, S.W.; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 181-2017 authorizing the Director of Public Service through the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the lease/rental of a mobile LED screen; and declaring an emergency. *(Substitute Offered as an Amendment)* **VOTE 13-0**

ORD 182-2017 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement or agreements for the Community Recreation Project – Pass Through Grant Agreement from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the portion of the remedial design for the management of Gorge Dam contaminated sediments to facilitate the removal of the Gorge Dam; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

RES 183-2017 urging the General Assembly and Governor John Kasich to take the steps necessary to amend HB 49 to grant the 1545 park districts in the State of Ohio the same protections as the state parks and nature preserves when it comes to being placed in natural gas or oil units; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

RES 184-2017 expressing opposition to the proposed federal budget put forth by President Trump and urging President Trump, members of Congress, and other policy makers in Washington to pass a fiscally responsible budget that does not hurt the most vulnerable among us and that invests in the future of our nation; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**

RES 185-2017 expressing opposition to the United States’ recent withdraw from the Paris Agreement on Climate Control (the “Paris Agreement”) and offering support for the Paris Agreement and its goal of combating climate change on an international level; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 13-0**
