ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 24, 2017:

ORD 241-2017 approving the sale of a vacant City-owned properties pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program; determining said properties are not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 11-0 (Neal Abstained) (Hoch Absent)**

ORD 242-2017 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by Aaron and Louise Bane, under a land contract with John Richards, Jr., located at 454 Wellington Avenue, for the purposes of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging, and reconstructing a sewer or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage and waterline purposes in connection with the Hazel Street Storage Basin Project (CSO Racks 10/11); declaring the intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code Section 163.06(A) and Article I; Section 19 of the Ohio Constitution for the appropriation of real property due to a public exigency; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 11-0 (Neal Abstained) (Hoch Absent)**

ORD 243-2017 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by Jeannette Bray, David Maddox, Margaret Parmis, Lawrence Maddox, and Leonard Maddox, located at 246 Eastland Avenue, for the purposes of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging, and reconstructing a sewer or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage and waterline purposes in connection with the Hazel Street Storage Basin Project (CSO Racks 10/11); declaring the intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code Section 163.06(A) and Article I; Section 19 of the Ohio Constitution for the appropriation of real property due to a public exigency; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 11-0 (Neal Abstained) (Hoch Absent)**

ORD 244-2017 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of metalworking and fabrication equipment for the Motor Equipment Division; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 11-0 (Neal Abstained) (Hoch Absent)**

ORD 245-2017 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract or contracts for the repair of the roof at Joy Park Community Center; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 11-0 (Neal Abstained) (Hoch Absent)**

ORD 246-2017 declaring it necessary to improve various off-street parking facilities in the Kenmore Business District and the Canton Road Business District by sealing, resurfacing and repairing, painting parking space stripes, sweeping, removing snow, cleaning sewer openings, providing lawn, turf, shrub and tree maintenance, litter and other general clean-up and otherwise improving and maintaining the same, and all when and where necessary; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 11-0 (Neal Abstained) (Hoch Absent)**

ORD 247-2017 authorizing the Mayor to enter into and execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with Summit County and various other jurisdictions for the shared purchase, implementation and use of Matrix Case Management Software; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0 (Hoch Absent)**

ORD 248-2017 authorizing the Mayor to license or lease a portion of 952 E. Exchange Street to the Battered Women's Shelter of Summit & Medina Counties for the creation of a playground; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0 (Hoch Absent)**

ORD 249-2017 authorizing the Mayor to apply for grant funding through AMATS for Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) funds that are available for use in the City of Akron's complete street improvement project to North Main Street; authorizing the expenditure of local funds in support of this grant; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0 (Hoch Absent)**

RES 250-2017 urging the United States Congress not to repeal the Affordable Care Act without a viable replacement proposal; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0 (Hoch Absent)**
