**BUDGET & FINANCE:**

1. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Finance or the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with SolarWinds for the purchase of information technology maintenance services and related software; and declaring an emergency.

**PLANNING:**

2. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a short term vacation rental at 2112 Cross Creek Trail; and declaring an emergency. (Up for Public Hearing 9/18)

3. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a medical marijuana cultivation facility at 3081 Gilchrist Road; and declaring an emergency. (Up for Public Hearing 9/18)

4. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a commercial use at 982 Oakland Avenue; and declaring an emergency. (Up for Public Hearing 9/18)

5. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a garage at 554 Weber Avenue; and declaring an emergency. (Up for Public Hearing 9/25)

6. ORDINANCE ratifying the actions of the Director of Planning and Urban Development in contracting on an emergency basis with Vegetation Control Co. of N.E. Ohio (“Vegetation”) for mowing of city-owned lots; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. (Up for Public Hearing 9/25)

**PUBLIC SERVICE:**

7. ORDINANCE levying special assessments for the improvement of East Market Street in the City by paving, grading, constructing, reconstructing and installing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches, all together with the necessary appurtenances thereto; all in accordance with the Petition submitted by the property owner of the benefitted property; and declaring an emergency.

8. ORDINANCE levying special assessments and determining to proceed with the improvement of various off-street parking facilities in the Kenmore Business District and the Canton Road Business District by sealing, resurfacing and repairing, painting parking space stripes, sweeping, removing snow, cleaning sewer openings, providing lawn, turf, shrub and tree maintenance, litter and other general clean-up and otherwise improving and maintaining the same, and all when and where necessary; and declaring an emergency.

9. ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the repair and/or replacement of the concrete apron located at or around the Fire Maintenance Building, 2474 Triplett Blvd.; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC UTILITIES**

10. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the installation of a non-potable water meter vault at the Akron Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency.

11. ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase of various equipment, materials and labor in order to complete certain concrete work at the Akron Water Plant located at 1570 Ravenna Road in Kent, Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

12. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the replacement of two (2) electric distribution switches at the Akron Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC SAFETY:**

13. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and accept, if awarded, a grant from the Ohio Attorney General's Office for comprehensive opioid abuse initiatives; and declaring an emergency.

14. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and accept, if awarded, a grant administered through the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance designed to provide law enforcement agencies with the flexibility to prioritize and utilize justice funds where they are needed most; and declaring an emergency.

**MISCELLANEOUS:**

15. RESOLUTION declaring the second Monday in October as Indigenous Peoples' Day in the City of Akron, Ohio; encouraging other governmental entities and institutions to recognize the Day; promoting the well-being and growth of the Native American and Indigenous community; encouraging the public to actively promote ethnic and racial healing efforts throughout the community; and declaring an emergency.

16. RESOLUTION supporting the passage of State of Ohio legislation that would create "The Ohio Drug Price Relief Act," known as Ohio Issue 2, which will require Ohio and its agencies and programs to purchase prescription drugs at prices no higher than what the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (the "VA") pays; and declaring an emergency.
