ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 2, 2017:

ORD 298-2017 amending and/or supplementing Ordinance No. 198-2014, authorizing the Director of Finance to enter into an agreement or agreements with authorized service providers to provide additional deferred compensation investment options to City employees; to select and remove additional financial institutions as investment options from time to time; and declaring an emergency. (9/18/17) **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 299-2017 authorizing the Mayor to file an application with assurances and certifications with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Continuum of Care Application for Stewart B. McKinney funds for the homeless; and declaring an emergency. (9/18/17) **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 300-2017 accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission of Summit County and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the Summit County Fiscal Officer; and declared an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

RES 301-2017 requesting that the Summit County Fiscal Officer make an advanced payment of tax funds for tax year 2017 payable in 2018 to the City of Akron Treasury Division; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 302-2017 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$20,000,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to retire notes issued for the purpose of providing funds to pay the costs of various improvements in the City; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 303-2017 providing for the issuance and sale of notes in a principal amount not exceeding \$13,500,000 to pay the property owners' portion, in anticipation of the levy and collection of special assessments, of the cost of improving certain streets in the City, between certain termini, by providing street-cleaning services and street lighting; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 304-2017 providing for the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$500,000 of bonds, to pay, in anticipation of the collection of special assessments heretofore levied, the property owners' portion of the cost of improving certain streets in the City; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 305-2017 providing for the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$3,300,000 of bonds, to pay, in anticipation of the collection of special assessments heretofore levied, the property owners' portion of the cost of improving East Market Street in the City by paving, grading, constructing, reconstructing and installing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches, all together with the necessary appurtenances thereto; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 306-2017 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$4,485,000, for the purpose of refunding certain maturities of general obligation bonds of the City issued in 2010; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 307-2017 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$15,160,000, for the purpose of refunding certain maturities of general obligation bonds of the City issued in 2010; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 308-2017 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$4,000,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to retire notes issued for the purpose of providing funds to pay expenses associated with the settlement of health care claims, whether by reserve or otherwise, and the City's portion of the costs of maintaining its self-insurance program for employee health care benefits; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 309-2017 providing for the issuance and sale of bonds of the City in a maximum principal amount of \$191,195,000 for the purpose of refunding bonds issued by the City in 2010 to pay the costs of acquiring, constructing, improving, renovating, repairing, enlarging, adding to, reconstructing, maintaining, equipping, furnishing, acquiring interests in real property in connection with, improving the sites of, and otherwise improving, Community Learning Centers, and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 310-2017 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$23,660,000, for the purpose of refunding certain maturities of income tax revenue bonds of the City issued in 2014; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 311-2017 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$500,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of improving municipal buildings and facilities in the City by constructing, reconstructing, renovating, repairing roofs, remodeling, relocating, making site and other improvements, planning and designing facilities and acquiring and installing related equipment, all as applicable, designated or to be designated by the Director of Public Services; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 312-2017 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$2,500,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of acquiring and equipping motor vehicles for certain Divisions in the City; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 313-2017 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$200,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of improving the municipal parks and recreational system in the City; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 314-2017 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$1,100,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of certain economic development projects in the City; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 315-2017 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$5,700,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of constructing, reconstructing, and otherwise improving certain streets in the City; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 316-2017 repealing and replacing Ordinance No. 40-2017, creating, establishing, and recognizing departments, offices, bureaus, divisions and positions in the classified service of the City of Akron; requiring that only budgeted funded positions be filled; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

RES 317-2017 approving and confirming the appointment by the Mayor of Melinda Scalfaro as a member of the City Board of Zoning Appeals; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

RES 318-2017 approving and confirming the appointment of Mark Smith, Lianne Heppner, David Hawkins, Jaunae Carter, Mark Sweitzer, Charlie Ryder, and Kelvin Berry to the Urban Design and Historic Preservation Commission; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 319-2017 amending Title 3 "Administration," Chapter 31 "Departments, Boards, and Commissions," Section 31.391 "Urban Design and Historic Preservation Commission" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 320-2017 determining to proceed with and levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets in the City, between certain termini, by providing street-cleaning services and street lighting; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**

ORD 321-2017 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and accept if awarded a grant from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for the "Safety Intervention Grant for Firefighters' Exposure to Environmental Elements" for equipment; authorizing the Fire Chief through the Purchasing Agent to enter into an agreement or agreements to carry out the terms of the grant by purchasing the equipment necessary to carry out the purpose of the grant; authorizing the expenditure of local funds; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE 12-0**
