

AKRON CITY COUNCIL
New Legislation List-October 16, 2017

RULES:

0. Resolution expressing its continuing support for and urging the passage of Issue 4 on November 7, 2017; and declaring an emergency.

BUDGET & FINANCE:

0A. Ordinance authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, in partnership with the United Way of Summit County, to apply for grant funding through Bloomberg Philanthropies' Cities for Financial Empowerment Fund to attain a 2017 Financial Empowerment Center grant; and declaring an emergency.

0B. Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Whitespace for the redesign of the Akron Municipal Court website, the amount of which is not to exceed \$30,000; and declaring an emergency.

PLANNING:

1. Ordinance authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into an agreement or agreements with the Urban Neighborhood Development Corporation (UNDC) to provide for the construction and sale of moderate cost single-family homes on a non-profit basis within the Community Development Activity Area; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

2. Ordinance authorizing the City to donate an easement interest in City property to Children's Hospital Medical Center of Akron; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE:

3. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a Cooperation Agreement with AT&T; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC UTILITIES:

4. Ordinance ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, in entering into a contract with Sulzer Pump Services Inc. for the emergency removal, inspection, repair, and re-installation of two currently inoperable vertical turbine pumps at the Akron Water Plant; and declaring an emergency.

5. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with EMP Power & Water Solutions, Inc. for the purchase of Ovation Controllers to upgrade existing controllers during the Step Feed Improvement Project at the Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SAFETY:

6. Ordinance authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and to accept, if awarded, funding from the Northern Ohio Golf Charities, Inc. grant program; and declaring an emergency.

6A. Ordinance amending/supplementing Title 7 “Traffic Code,” Chapter 76 “Parking Regulations,” Article 1, “Generally,” of the Akron Codified Ordinances to amend Section 76.30 “Handicapped Parking”; and declaring an emergency.

HEALTH & SOCIAL SERVICE:

7. Resolution approving and confirming the appointments of Myoshi Levy, Connie Swain, and Karen Hrdlicka to the Senior Citizens Commission for terms ending August 1, 2020.

8. ORDINANCE establishing October 22-28, 2017, as Lead Poisoning Prevention Week and encouraging Akron parents and grandparents who care for children under the age of six to ensure a lead safe environment and participate in the Lead Prevention programs the City of Akron provides; and declaring an emergency.
