- 1 RES 355-2017 Urging the President of the United States and the United States Congress to continue the Federal Historic Tax Credit Program, and to otherwise provide respect thereto; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Hoch abstained, Freeman & Fusco absent)

- 2 ORD 356-2017 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an after school day care business center at 979 Copley Road; and declaring an

- 3 ORD 357-2017 authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into contracts with Wagner Enterprise, Inc., for the purchase of certain sodium hypochlorite tanks and related parts for use at the Akron Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency. - 4 ORD 358-2017 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into an agreement or agreements with The University of Akron ("University") and/or the State of Ohio allowing for the use of State-appropriated funds for capital improvements and/or other expenditures at City-owned property; and declaring an emergency.
