BUDGET & FINANCE

0. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Finance to enter into an agreement with The University of Akron School of Law to provide an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for its expungement program; and declaring an emergency.
1. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Finance to pay costs associated with the City’s participation in miscellaneous organizations, associations and agencies; and declaring an emergency.

2. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to vary the side yard setback to construct a garage addition at 769 Cordova Avenue; and declaring an emergency.
3. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a solid fence within the setback at 1643 Shirley Avenue; and declaring an emergency.
4. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a solid fence within the setback at 988 Annapolis Avenue; and declaring an emergency.
5. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a mental health rehabilitation center at 1009 Copley Road; and declaring an emergency.

ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, the Director of Public Service, the Director of Finance, and the Director of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of materials and services needed by the various divisions and departments of the City for a period of time not to exceed 3 years; approving the specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. **(Substitute offered as an Amendment)**

10. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, the Director of Public Service, the Director of Finance, the Director of Law, the Director of Planning and/or the Director of Neighborhood Assistance through the office of the Purchasing Agent to purchase miscellaneous supplies, services, repair parts and labor for machinery and equipment used by various divisions and departments of the City for a period of one (1) year; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SAFETY

11. ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract or contracts, without the formality of advertising for bids, for 28 ballistic helmets and vests from Blue Line Innovations, LLC., for the Akron Fire Division; and declaring an emergency.
