ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED 12-18-17

- 1 ORD 401-2017 declaring certain improvements to real property located in the White Pond – Frank Blvd Urban Renewal Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation, providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes and the deposit of those service payments in the appropriate fund, providing for the payment of a portion of said service payments to the Akron Public School District, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the “Act”); and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 2 RES 402-2017 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate fee simple interests in real property owned by Noah Zalewski, located at 408 Wellington Avenue, for the purposes of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging, and reconstructing a sewer or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage and waterline purposes in connection with the Hazel Street Storage Basin Project (CSO Racks 10/11); and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 3 ORD 403-2017 declaring improvements to certain real property located in the Eastgate II Urban Redevelopment Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation; declaring that construction and rehabilitation of certain real property is a public purpose; providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes and the deposit of those service payments in the Urban Redevelopment Tax Increment Equivalent Fund; providing for the payment of a portion of said service payments to the Akron Public School District; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 4 ORD 404-2017 authorizing the execution of a Contract for Sale of Land for Private Redevelopment with East Akron Neighborhood Development Corporation and EANDC Middlebury LLC, or their respective assignees; providing for the acquisition, sale and redevelopment of property in the Amended Middlebury Urban Renewal Plan Area; finding that such property is not needed for any public use, and related findings and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 5 ORD 405-2017 authorizing the Director of Public Service, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the replacement of the water transmission main beneath State Route 43 at Ravenna Road in Kent, Ohio; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 6 ORD 406-2017 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for needed repairs and improvements to kitchen facilities in two of the City's fire stations, in accordance with the 2017 Capital Improvement Plan; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 7 ORD 407-2017 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into a grant agreement with Rogers Industrial Products, Inc.; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 8 ORD 408-2017 authorizing the City to grant an easement interest in City property to Cleveland Clinic/Akron General Hospital; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 9 ORD 409-2017 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an oversized accessory structure at 2095 Forest Edge Drive; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 10 ORD 410-2017 authorizing the Director of Finance to enter into an agreement with The University of Akron School of Law to provide an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for its expungement program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 11 ORD 411-2017 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay costs associated with the City's participation in miscellaneous organizations, associations and agencies; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 12 ORD 412-2017 amending Ordinance 380-2017 to include an additional parcel in the sale of various City-owned properties to JAR Enterprises Ohio, LLC; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 13 ORD 413-2017 authorizing the Mayor, the Director of Public Service, the Director of Finance, and the Director of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of materials and services needed by the various divisions and departments of the City for a period of time not to exceed 3 years; approving the specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. (Substitute offered as an Amendment) VOTE 13-0

- 14 ORD 414-2017 authorizing the Mayor, the Director of Public Service, the Director of Finance, the Director of Law, the Director of Planning and/or the Director of Neighborhood Assistance through the office of the Purchasing Agent to purchase miscellaneous supplies, services, repair parts and labor for machinery and equipment used by various divisions and departments of the City for a period of one (1) year; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 15 ORD 415-2017 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract or contracts, without the formality of advertising for bids, for 28 ballistic helmets and vests from Blue Line Innovations, LLC., for the Akron Fire Division; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 16 ORD 416-2017 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract or contracts, without the formality of advertising for bids, for four (4) mobile radios from Motorola Solutions for Akron Fire Division command vehicles; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 17 ORD 417-2017 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract or contracts, without the formality of advertising for bids, for 15 Lenovo Computers, service plans, docks, and DVD burners from Lenovo for new Akron Police Division vehicles; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
