### **ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED JANUARY 22, 2018**

- 1 ORD 6-2018 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract or contracts with United Way of Summit County to implement the 2017 Financial Empowerment Center grant from Bloomberg Philanthropies' Cities for Financial Empowerment Fund; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
  
- 2 ORD 7-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with Protech Oilfield Services to plug and abandon City Gas Well No. 16; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
  
- 3 ORD 8-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract or contracts, without the formality of advertising for bids, for the purchase and installation of bollards, a concrete walk, and concrete pad at the Akron Water Plant; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
  
- 5 ORD 10-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract or contracts, without the formality of advertising for bids, for a one-year maintenance agreement from Itron for the existing handheld AMR water meter reading field collector units; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
  
- 6 ORD 11-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for one-hundred-two (102) Herman Miller chairs and twenty two (22) Kinston training/task tables for use in the Akron Police Department Training Bureau; and declaring an emergency. (Substitute Offered as an Amendment) VOTE 13-0
  
- 7 ORD 12-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a mental health rehabilitation center at 1009 Copley Road; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 8 ORD 13-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to vary the side yard setback to construct a garage addition at 769 Cordova Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 9 RES 14-2018 expressing Council's support for integrated planning and new affordability consideration for water; and declaring and emergency. VOTE 10-0 (Kammer, Hoch abstained)
- 10 RES 15-2018 requesting the administration to enact a LIFT-UP program as part of a comprehensive plan to provide water to those residents who need financial assistance; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-1 (Kammer) (Keith, Hoch abstained)
- 11 ORD 16-2018 approving and authorizing the execution of a Lease Agreement with the Akron Community Service Center and Urban League, Inc., or its designee (the "Akron Urban League") for land near Rhodes and Berry Avenues, in order to facilitate the development of an urban farm; finding such property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 12 ORD 17-2018 approving the Project Petition for Special Assessments for Special Energy Improvement Projects, as amended, related to the acquisition, construction, installation, and improvement of certain public improvements in the City of Akron, Ohio in cooperation with the Akron Energy Special Improvement District; approving the necessity of that project; determining to proceed with that project; levying special assessments for the purpose of paying the costs of that project; approving a Cooperative Agreement and a Special Assessment Agreement related to that project; and declaring an emergency. (Substitute Offered As An Amendment) VOTE 13-0
