ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED JAN. 29, 2018

- 1 RES 18-2018 approving and confirming the reappointment of Stephen A. Stock to the Akron Civil Service Commission; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 2 RES-19-2018 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate fee simple interests in real property owned by Tammera Pasclely (fka Tammera Gaffney), located at 339 Chittenden Street, for the purposes of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging, and reconstructing a sewer or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage, and waterline purposes in connection with the CSO Rack 3 Kelly Green Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 3 ORD 20-2018 approving the sale of a vacant City-owned properties pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of property and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 4 RES 21-2018 approving and confirming the appointments of Mayor Daniel Horrigan, John Moore, Thomas Tatum, Helen Tomic, Councilwomen Veronica Sims and Tara Mosley-Samples, and Councilman Bob Hoch for the year 2018 as members of the Northeast Ohio Four County Regional Planning and Development Organization, with alternates Samuel DeShazior (Mayor Horrigan), Jim Ashley (Tatum), Michelle DiFiore (Moore) and Brent Hendren (Tomic); and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 5 ORD 22-2018 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to file applications and enter into agreements with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for grant funding to create a new section of the Rubber City Heritage Trail; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 6 ORD 23-2018 authorizing the Mayor to file applications and enter into an agreement/agreements with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for funding to repair and/or replace certain air circulation fans located at the Cascade Parking Garage; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 7 ORD 24-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the repair and/or replacement of air circulation fans located in the Cascade Parking Garage fan room; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 8 ORD 25-2018 authorizing the Mayor to file applications and enter into an agreement/agreements with the Ohio EPA and Ohio Water Development Authority for funding through the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund for the repair and/or replacement of certain wastewater infrastructure; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 9 ORD 26-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the repair and/or replacement of certain portions of the Akron sanitary sewer system; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 10 RES 27-2018 declaring it necessary to improve Brittain Road between the termini of Tallmadge Avenue and Independence Avenue by constructing and reconstructing curbs and concrete sidewalks; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 11 ORD 28-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and accept sponsorship funding from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency to be utilized in the purchase and eventual restoration of certain land adjacent to Lake Rockwell Reservoir; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into an agreement or agreements to carry out the purposes of the sponsorship program; authorizing the expenditure of funds; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 12 ORD 29-2018 authorizing the Director of Law to enter into a contract with the Summit County Public Defender Commission to provide legal services for indigent defendants in Akron Municipal Court, in accordance with the requirements of the Constitution of the United States with respect to the provision of legal representation to indigent defendants; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 13 ORD 30-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into a grant agreement with Rogers Industrial Products, Inc.; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 14 RES 31-2018 recognizing and honoring the history and culture of Native Americans, and the contributions by tribal nations to the development of the American continent, and acknowledging the efforts to preserve this history in our country, in Akron, Summit County, and Ohio by establishing “North America First People’s Day” on the first Monday of October; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 15 ORD 32-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a solid fence within the setback at 988 Annapolis Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 16 ORD 33-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a solid fence within the setback at 1643 Shirley Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 17 ORD 34-2018 authorizing the acceptance of property by donation at 800 George Washington Blvd. for Rubber Bowl Development purposes; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Samples Abstained)
- 18 ORD 35-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with Promats Athletics for the purchase and installation of netting at Canal Park Stadium; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 19 ORD 36-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to purchase 20 sets of protective fire gear in addition to the 50 previously authorized by Ordinance 110-2017; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
