ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED FEBRUARY 5, 2018

- 1 ORD 37-2018 authorizing the Mayor to apply for and to enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio, Department of Education, for After School Program grants for the 2018-2019 school year; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)

- 2 RES 38-2018 approving the renewal application of George and Julia Reese to have agricultural property on Courtland Avenue to be included in an “agricultural district” pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01, et seq.; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing was held February 5, 2018) VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)

- 3 RES 39-2018 approving the renewal application of Bessemer Farms Ltd., Bessemer Farms Ltd. II, and Anna J. Bessemer Trust to have agricultural property on St. Michaels, Courtland and Nye Street to be included in an “agricultural district” pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01, et seq.; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing was held February 5, 2018) VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)

- 4 RES 40-2018 approving the renewal application of Donald E. and Carol Bessemer to have agricultural property on St. Michaels Avenue to be included in an “agricultural district” pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01, et seq.; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing was held February 5, 2018) VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)

- 5 ORD 41-2018 authorizing an amendment to the 2017 Consolidated Plan and Community Development/HOME Program to authorize the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development Section 108 Loan Guarantee application for The Bowery Project; authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to enter into all necessary agreements for the operation and term of the activities; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing was held 2/5/18) VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)

- 6 ORD 42-2018 authorizing the Mayor to enter into and execute the cooperative agreement with the County of Summit, the Akron City School District, and the United Way of Summit County; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)

- 7 RES 43-2018 adopting the 2018 Capital Investment and Community Development Program, legally referred to as the Capital Investment Budget; and declaring an emergency. Substitute Offered as an Amendment. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)

- 8 RES 44-2018 urging Attorney General Michael DeWine to withdraw the State of Ohio's appeal to the Supreme Court of Ohio of the decision issued by the Eighth District Court of Appeals in Cleveland v. Ohio, 8th Dist. Cuyahoga No. 105500, 2017-Ohio-8882; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)

- 9 RES 45-2018 congratulating LeBron James on scoring his 30,000th point, expressing appreciation for his significant civic and charitable commitment to the Akron community, and wishing him well in his 2017-2018 season with the Cleveland Cavaliers; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
