ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED FEBRUARY 12, 2018

- 1 ORD 46-2018 authorizing the purchase of 1165 Bittaker St. and 1152 5th Ave. for the CSO Rack 3 (Kelly Green) Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 2 ORD 47-2018 approving the donation of City-owned land located at 1802 Baker Ave. (formerly 469 Massillon Rd.) to the Urban Neighborhood Development Corporation (UNDC), determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 3 ORD 48-2018 approving the sale of a vacant City-owned properties pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of activating underutilized spaces for the benefit of the community, and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 4 ORD 49-2018 accepting various right-of-way documents for 632 & 642 Dayton St. to facilitate the completion of the SUM 261 - Tallmadge Avenue Project; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 5 ORD 50-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Gray Matter Systems for the purchase of a GE iFix Global Care Complete software support package for the Water Supply Bureau, for a period of time not to exceed three years; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 6 ORD 51-2018 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Canal Construction Co., Cioffi Constructions Co., H.M. Miller Construction Co., and Spano Construction for emergency repair of 12 water mains in the City due to extreme winter conditions; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 7 ORD 52-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an office facility at 539 White Pond Drive; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 8 ORD 53-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct the Center for Advanced Energy Technology (CAET) building at 885 Mull Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 9 ORD 54-2018 approving the 2018 Akron Neighborhood Maintenance and Empowerment Program; authorizing the Director of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bid proposals, for services related to mowing of publicly-owned lots, workforce and skills training, and career assistance; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman did not vote)

- 10 ORD 55-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and/or legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the construction of the Canton Road Resurfacing Project, for certain improvements from the southern municipal corporation limits to Wedgewood Drive; authorizing the appropriation and/or expenditure of funds; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman did not vote)

- 11 ORD 56-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase of five (5) washer-

- 12 ORD 57-2018 authorizing the Mayor, through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract after accepting informal sealed bids, for the purchase of uniform materials for the Fire Division; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman did not vote)

- 13 RES 58-2018 expressing support for the enactment of Ohio Revised Code Section 5.2516, which designates the month of February as “Teen Dating Violence Awareness Month” in the State of Ohio, and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
