ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED FEBRUARY 26, 2018

- 1 ORD 59-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract without the formality of advertising for bids, with MTech for the purchase of GraniteNet Inspection software and/or associated services; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 2 ORD 60-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a medical marijuana dispensary at 1912 Buchholzer Boulevard; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 3 ORD 61-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish medical marijuana processing at 1956 South Main Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 4 ORD 62-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to install two brine wells west of Manchester Road, south of the Tuscarawas River; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 5 ORD 63-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality publicly advertising for bids, to enter into contracts for the purchase of 911 call center hardware and software on behalf of the City of Stow; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Sims, Samples abstained)

- 6 RES 64-2018 calling on the Ohio General Assembly to enact a ban on the sale of assault-style weapons, ammunition magazines in excess of ten rounds, and modifications that simulate automated fire such as bump stocks and trigger cranks; and declaring an emergency. 11-2 (Kammer, Hoch)

- 7 RES 65-2018 expressing the heartfelt sympathy of the City of Akron to the families and friends of the victims of the shooting at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, Florida; extending wishes of healing for the Stoneman Douglas community in this time of tragedy; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 8 RES 66-2018 acknowledging the life of Reverend Billy Graham and expressing condolences to his family on this passing; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
