BUDGET & FINANCE

1. ORDINANCE amending/supplementing Title 9 “General Provisions,” Chapter 104 “Income Tax Ordinance” in order to reflect changes improperly mandated by Ohio House Bill 49 (HB 49), reserving the right to continue litigating an ongoing challenge to HB 49, recognizing that several provisions may be invalidated or stayed as a result of that challenge, and declaring an emergency. **(Substitute Offered as an Amendment)**

2. ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Engaged Public for the purchase of one-year subscriptions to Balancing Act PRO, Taxpayer Receipt, and Meeting Mode software services for use by the City Council and the residents of the City; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE

3. RESOLUTION declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2018 Phases I, II and III Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface, and declaring an emergency.

4. RESOLUTION declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2018 Phase I, II and III Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency.

5. ORDINANCE declaring the necessity of, determining to proceed with, and levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets in the City by constructing, reconstructing and repairing concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, curbs and retaining walls and installing roof drain pipes; all in accordance with petitions submitted by property owners under the 2017 City-Wide Sidewalk Program; and declaring an emergency.

6. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the construction of City Sidewalks 2018; and declaring an emergency.

7. RESOLUTION declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2018 Phase I, III and III Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency.

8. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the construction of Kelly (CSO Rack 3); and declaring an emergency.

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PUBLIC SAFETY

9. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and enter into an agreement for funding through the Road to Zero initiative administered by the National Safety Council to secure funding for overtime and to purchase speed enforcement equipment; and declaring an emergency.

10. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and enter into an agreement for funding from the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation to be utilized in the purchase of 40 ballistic helmets to outfit each member of the Akron Police Department SWAT team; and declaring an emergency.

HEALTH & SOCIAL SERVICE:

10a. ORDINANCE amending/supplementing Title 13, “General Offenses,” Chapter 130 “General Provisions,” Section 130.02 “Definitions” and Title 13 “General Offenses,” Chapter 139 “Miscellaneous,” Section 139.09 “Illegal distribution of cigarettes or other tobacco products” of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Akron to prohibit the sale of cigarettes, other tobacco products, and tobacco product paraphernalia to individuals under the age of twenty-one; authorizing a contract with the Summit County Combined General Health District to implement these provisions through regulations; and declaring an emergency.

GREEN/SUSTAINABILITY

11. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with the Summit Soil & Water Conservation District for the Akron Waterways Renewed Rain Barrel Program; and declaring an emergency.
