ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 26, 2018

- 1 ORD 91-2018 declaring the necessity of, determining to proceed with, and levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets in the City by constructing, reconstructing and repairing concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, curbs and retaining walls and installing roof drain pipes; all in accordance with petitions submitted by property owners under the 2017 City-Wide Sidewalk Program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith Absent)

- 2 ORD 92-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the construction of City Sidewalks 2018; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith Absent)

- 3 ORD 93-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the construction of Kelly (CSO Rack 3); and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith Absent)

- 4 ORD 94-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and enter into an agreement for funding from the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation to be utilized in the purchase of 40 ballistic helmets to outfit each member of the Akron Police Department SWAT team; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith Absent)

- 5 ORD 95-2018 determining to proceed with the improvement of Brittain Road between the termini of Tallmadge Avenue and Independence Avenue by constructing and reconstructing curbs and concrete sidewalks; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith Absent)

- 6 ORD 96-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to submit an application and enter into an agreement with the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority for a Community Recycling Access Grant, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of supporting new and existing community recycling projects which would sustain and increase recycling activities within Summit County; and declaring an emergency. - 7 RES 97-2018 amending and restating Exhibit A to Resolution No. 86-2018 passed March 19, 2018, with respect to the 2018 Phases I, II and III Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith Absent)

- 8 RES 98-2018 amending Resolution No. 88-2018 passed March 19, 2018 with respect to the 2018 Phase I, II and III Residential Resurfacing Program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Keith Absent)
