### **ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 2, 2018**

- 1 ORD 99-2018 approving the sale of a vacant City-owned properties pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of activating underutilized spaces for the benefit of the community, and reducing the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Swirsky Absent)
  
- 2 ORD 100-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Engaged Public for the purchase of one-year subscriptions to Balancing Act PRO, Taxpayer Receipt, and Meeting Mode software services for use by the City Council and the residents of the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 8-4 (Fusco, Hoch, Kammer, Keith) (Swirsky Absent)
  
- 3 RES 101-2018 recognizing the 50th anniversary of the assassination of Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King Jr; honoring the legacy of Dr. King; challenging all Americans to fulfill his dream and complete his mission; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Swirsky Absent)
  
- 4 ORD 102-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the relocation and construction of a new Akron Fire Station No. 2 located at or around 952 E. Exchange Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Swirsky Absent)
