ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 7, 2018

- 1 ORD 143-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into contracts using Community University Education Purchasing Association (CUE) bids, National Joint Powers Association (NJPA) bids or State of Ohio bids, or after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and/or lease of various vehicles and equipment; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kilby did not vote) (Samples absent)
- 2 ORD 144-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the replacement of the
- 3 ORD 145-2018 authorizing the Mayor and/or the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement or agreements with neighboring communities and/or the County of Summit for participation and cost sharing in the 2018 Resurfacing Program and the 2018 Construction Seal and Crack Filling Program, in order to improve roadways in split jurisdictions; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kilby did not vote) (Samples absent)
- 4 ORD 146-2018 determining to proceed with the improvement of Canton Road between the termini of Wedgewood Drive and the southern corporate limit and between the termini of East Market Street and State Route 76 by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kilby did not vote) (Samples absent)
- 5 ORD 147-2018 authorizing the Mayor to apply for and enter into agreements with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for funding for the Eastwood Pump Replacement Project and the 2018 Annual Water Main Construction Program; designating the Mayor and others as the authorized representatives for the loan applications; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kilby did not vote) (Samples absent)

- 6 ORD 148-2018 authorizing the Mayor to apply for, and if awarded, accept a Violence Against Women Act grant administered by the Office of Criminal Justice Services; authorizing the Director of Law to enter into an agreement with Oriana House, Inc. to implement the grant by continuing to fund two investigators for the domestic violence unit; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kilby did not vote) (Samples absent)

- 7 ORD 149-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase of sixteen LED high mast light fixtures; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kilby did not vote) (Samples absent)

- 8 ORD 150-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a training and research center at 815-833 Carroll Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Samples absent)

- 9 ORD 151-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish equipment rental business and to construct a new building at 1081 Eastwood Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Samples absent)
