ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 14, 2018

- 1 RES 152-2018 declaring it necessary to improve Forest Edge Drive, Aeries Way, Carriage Hill Lane, Fox Trace Trail, High Hampton Trail, Timberline Trail, Bent Creek Trail and Deer Ridge Run between certain termini by paving; grading and resurfacing; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Hoch, Kammer absent)

- 2 ORD 153-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for upgraded replacement parts for the primary tanks at the City's Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Hoch, Kammer absent)

- 3 ORD 154-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with Axon Enterprises for the purchase of Tasers and Taser related equipment; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Hoch, Kammer absent)

- 4 ORD 155-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to purchase up to 37 Lenovo computers, 5 docks and 5 DVD players from Lenovo Government; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Hoch, Kammer absent)

- 5 ORD 156-2018 amending/supplementing Title 15, Chapter 153, "Zoning Code", Section 153.140 "Definitions" and Section 153.310 "Business and Industry requirements" creating Urban Overlay (UO) Areas; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Hoch, Kammer absent)

- 9 ORD 160-2018 approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board selected pursuant to Section 53.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City and Resolution No. 87-2018, to hear and determine all objections to the special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini in accordance with Resolution No. 87-2018 (2018 Phase I, II and III Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program); determining to proceed with the improvement; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Hoch, Kammer absent)

- 10 ORD 161-2018 approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board selected pursuant to Section 53.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City and Resolution No. 88-2018, as amended by Resolution No. 98-2018, to hear and determine all objections to the special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini in accordance with Resolution No. 88-2018, as amended by Resolution No. 98-2018 (2018 Phase I, II and III Residential Resurfacing Program); determining to proceed with the improvement; and declaring an emergency. - 11 ORD 162-2018 approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board selected pursuant to Section 53.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City and Resolution No. 86-2018, as amended by Resolution No. 97-2018, to hear and determine all objections to the special assessments for the improvement of certain streets between certain termini in accordance with Resolution No. 86-2018, as amended by Resolution No. 97-2018 (2018 Phase I, II and III Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program); determining to proceed with the improvement; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Hoch, Kammer absent)

- 12 ORD 163-2018 authorizing the Director of Neighborhood Assistance to enter into a contract without the formality of publicly advertising for bids with the Board of Education, Akron City School District to provide meal preparation and delivery services as part of the City's annual Summer Food Service Program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Hoch, Kammer absent)

- 13 ORD 164-2018 authorizing the expenditure of funds in support of Akron's Summer Reading Program 2018, to combat "summer slide" and help Akron students maintain and enhance reading achievement over the summer; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Hoch, Kammer absent)
