PLANNING

0. ORDINANCE declaring improvements to certain parcels of real property to be a public purpose, describing the public improvements to be made to directly benefit those parcels, requiring the owner of the improvements thereon to make service payments in lieu of taxes, for deposit into a municipal public improvement tax increment equivalent fund, and related authorizations pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.40, 5709.42 and 5709.43; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE

1. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the replacement of the failed air conditioning unit at the Ellet Community Center; and declaring an emergency.

2. ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the planting of trees in connection with the restoration phase of the CSO program known as “CSO Tree Planting 2018”; and declaring an emergency.

3. ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase and delivery of trees for tree giveaways associated with the CSO program; and declaring an emergency.

4. ORDINANCE ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service of entering into a contract with NBW, Inc. for the emergency replacement of the boiler at Good Park Golf Course; and declaring an emergency

5. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to apply for, and enter into grant agreement, if awarded, with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the reconstruction of Taxiway H1, rehabilitation of Aprons A & B, rehabilitation of Runway 7-25 electrical, removal of obstruction at end of Runway 7, and pavement markings of Runway 7-25; and declaring an emergency.

6. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with The K Company for emergency replacement of the chilled water coils and air handler for the Stubbs Justice Center; and declaring an emergency.

6A. RESOLUTION declaring it necessary to improve various off-street parking facilities in the Kenmore Business District and the Canton Road Business District by sealing, resurfacing and repairing, painting parking space stripes, sweeping, removing snow, cleaning sewer openings, providing lawn, turf, shrub and tree maintenance, litter and other general clean-up and otherwise improving and maintaining the same, and all when and where necessary; and declaring an emergency.

6B. RESOLUTION declaring it necessary to improve certain streets in the City, between certain termini, by providing street-cleaning services and street lighting; and declaring an emergency.

7. ORDINANCE ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Cioffi Construction Co., Inc. for emergency repair of a 16-inch water main on Middleton Road; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency.
