- 1 ORD 165-2018 approving the donation of City-owned property; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kammer, Omobien absent)
- 2 ORD 166-2018 authorizing the purchase of real property on 5th Avenue, McKinley Avenue, and 479 Chittenden Street for the CSO Rack 3 (Kelly Green) Project; authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee to enter into related agreements; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kammer, Omobien absent)
- 3 ORD 167-2018 authorizing the purchase of real property for the CSO Rack 10/11 Storage Basin Project; authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee to enter into related agreements; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kammer, Omobien absent)
- 4 ORD 168-2018 authorizing the purchase of various interests in real property located on or around Wellington Avenue to facilitate the completion of CSO Rack 10/11 (Storage Basin) Project; authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee to enter into related agreements; authorizing payment for the same; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kammer, Omobien absent)
- 5 ORD 169-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and grant an easement on City-owned property near Front Street to The East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a Dominion Energy Ohio; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kammer, Omobien absent)
- 6 ORD 170-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase of plate carrier systems for use by the Akron Police Department; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kammer, Omobien absent)

- 7 ORD 171-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the installation of office cubicles in the detective area of the Crime Scene Unit; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kammer, Omobien absent)

- 8 ORD 172-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase of high cut ballistic helmets for use by the Akron Police Department; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kammer, Omobien absent)

- 9 ORD 173-2018 declaring improvements to certain parcels of real property to be a public purpose, describing the public improvements to be made to directly benefit those parcels, requiring the owner of the improvements thereon to make service payments in lieu of taxes, for deposit into a municipal public improvement tax increment equivalent fund, and related authorizations pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.40, 5709.42 and 5709.43; and declaring an emergency. - 10 ORD 174-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase and delivery of trees for tree giveaways associated with the CSO program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Kammer, Omobien absent)

- 11 ORD 175-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to apply for, and enter into grant agreement, if awarded, with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the reconstruction of Taxiway H1, rehabilitation of Aprons A & B, rehabilitation of Runway 7-25 electrical, removal of obstruction at end of Runway 7, and pavement markings of Runway 7-25; and declaring an emergency.
