BUDGET & FINANCE

1. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, in partnership with the United Way of Summit County, to apply for grant funding through the Cities for Financial Empowerment Fund to attain the 2018 Financial Empowerment Center Implementation grant; and declaring an emergency.

- 1A. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with Summit County and the cities of Cuyahoga Falls, Fairlawn, Green, and Stow for the acquisition, installation, and operation of a consolidated computer aided dispatch system; and declaring an emergency.

2. ORDINANCE amending The Zoning Map by changing the Retail Business Use District Classification (U3, H2, A3) Use on property located on the east side of South Arlington Street, south of Palmetto Avenue and west of Modena Drive, aka Parcel Nos. 6763734 and 6763755, to a Commercial Use District Classification (U4, H1, A2) Use; and declaring an emergency. *(Public Hearing Scheduled for June 11, 2018)*
