### ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 18, 2018

- 1 ORD 210-2018 accepting a vacation plat for a portion of Coburn Street, north of West Thornton Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 2 ORD 211-2018 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into, execute and deliver a Ground Lease and Lease Agreement with the Development Finance Authority of Summit County in connection with the financing and construction of the City's Fire Station No. 4 and new administrative facilities for the City; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 3 ORD 212-2018 approving and authorizing the execution of a Lease with the Board of Education of the Akron City School District for real property located on Thornton Street, in order to construct the new Fire Station No. 4, which will also house fire administration and certain countywide resources; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 4 ORD 213-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to file applications and enter into agreements with the Water Supply Revolving Loan Account for loans to fund certain Water Supply Bureau projects; designating authorized representatives for the applications; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 5 ORD 214-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase and installation of a new concrete tank foundation for use at the Akron Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 6 ORD 215-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee, to apply for and if awarded, accept grant funding through the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance as part of the National Sexual Assault Kit Initiative to address cold case sexual assault matters; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 7 ORD 216-2018 authorizing the Director of Neighborhood Assistance or his designee to enter into a contract with Ray Bertolini Trucking Co., for the demolition of various structures located within the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 8 RES 217-2018 expressing support for the mission of Akron Waterways Renewed (AWR) to invest in Akron's environmental future by building infrastructure for the next century that will protect public health and maintain water of the highest quality in the most cost-effective manner while providing local jobs for the citizens of Akron; expressing support for the proposed Second Amendment to the 2014 Consent Decree with the City of Akron as lodged by the United States with the United States District Court on June 5, 2018; and declaring an emergency. - 9 ORD 218-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for mowing services for public property, including water-distribution and pump-station sites; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
