ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 25, 2018

- 1 ORD 219-2018 authorizing the acquisition of land located in Auburn Township, Ohio, containing approximately 8.5488 acres in area, and known as Geauga County permanent parcel number 01-709025, from the Western Reserve Land Conservancy; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 2 ORD 220-2018 approving and authorizing the execution of a Redevelopment Agreement with 55 Furnace Street, LLC, or its designee, ("Redeveloper"), providing for the sale of property on Furnace Street for redevelopment pursuant to the Downtown Area Redevelopment Plan; finding such property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 3 ORD 221-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and/or legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for certain improvements on State Routes 18 and 261; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 4 ORD 222-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and/or legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for resurfacing certain streets and for certain bridge improvements ; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 5 ORD 223-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and/or legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for certain improvements on US-224; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 6 RES 224-2018 approving and confirming the appointments of Brenda Marina, John Frank, and Dr. Terry Albanese as citizen representatives, and Deputy Mayor for Public Safety Charles Brown as the Mayor's designee, and President Margo Sommerville and Councilwoman Marilyn Keith as representatives of City Council to the Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 7 ORD 225-2018 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to file applications and to enter into agreements for funding of certain capital improvements under the Ohio Public Works Commission's Local Transportation Improvement Program and State Capital Improvements Program; committing City funds for the local share of these improvements; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 8 ORD 226-2018 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into amendments (Supplement No. 2) to agreements between the City of Akron and Akron Energy Systems, LLC relating to the financing of certain improvements to the City's steam, hot water and chilled water system and the sale of certificates payable from payments made under such agreement; authorizing the execution of the amendment (Supplement No. 2) to the financing agreement; authorizing actions necessary and incidental thereto; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
