**RULES**

0. ORDINANCE authorizing and directing the submission to the electors of the City of Akron a proposal to amend Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Akron, to establish a May primary election date for municipal elections in the City of Akron, in order to reduce the cost of the primary election for Akron taxpayers and uphold the voting rights of military service members, to be voted upon at the next regular City-wide election on November 6, 2018; and declaring an emergency. (**Substitute Offered as an Amendment**)

**PLANNING**

1. ORDINANCE approving the Romig Road Redevelopment Plan; making necessary findings in connection therewith; and declaring an emergency. (Up for Public Hearing 7/23/18)
2. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an oversized garage at 369 E. Catawba Avenue; and declaring an emergency.
3. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use in order to establish two single-family dwellings at 436 N. Firestone Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.
4. ORDINANCE changing the name of First Merit Circle to Huntington Circle; and declaring an emergency.
5. ORDINANCE approving the sale of City-owned land located at 428 and 432 Crouse Street; authorizing the execution of related agreements; finding that the land is not needed for public purpose; and declaring an emergency.
6. ORDINANCE approving the sale of City-owned land located at 11 W. Emerling Avenue & VL S. Main Street; finding that the land is not needed for public purpose; and declaring an emergency.
7. ORDINANCE approving the sale of City-owned property located at 402 Grand Avenue; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
8. ORDINANCE authorizing the purchase of various interests in real property located in or around N. Case Avenue to facilitate the completion of the CSO Rack 10/11 (Storage Basin) Project; authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee to enter into related agreements; authorizing payment for the same; and declaring an emergency.

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9. ORDINANCE approving the sale of city owned land to NSA Holdings, LLC for urban redevelopment; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

**PUBLIC SERVICE**

10. ORDINANCE levying special assessments for the improvement of Firestone Parkway between the termini of Wilbeth Road and Firestone Boulevard and Firestone Boulevard between the termini of Firestone Parkway and South Main Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, storm sewers and sanitary sewers; installing street lighting; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.
11. ORDINANCE levying special assessments for the improvement of Wilbeth Road between the termini of Manchester Road and Dallas Avenue by paving; grading; resurfacing; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes and street lighting; and planting trees, all together with the necessary appurtenances thereto; and declaring an emergency.
12. ORDINANCE levying special assessments for the improvement of Englewood Avenue between the termini of Wigley Street and Massillon Road by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, sanitary sewers, storm sewers, and water mains; installing water service connections, sanitary sewer house laterals, and roof drain pipes; and declaring an emergency.
13. ORDINANCE levying special assessments for the improvement of Seiberling Way and Eagle Street between certain termini by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, storm sewers, sanitary sewers, sanitary sewer house laterals, water mains and water service connections; installing street lighting; and planting trees, all together with the necessary appurtenances; and declaring an emergency.

ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) vendors for the purchase of fire hydrants and restraining gland kits in conjunction with certain Ohio Public Works Commission requirements; and declaring an emergency.
15. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and grant a pipeline easement on City-owned property to Troy NGP Ltd.; and declaring an emergency.

ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly requesting qualifications and proposals, to enter into a contract or contracts for the construction of Hazel Storage Basin (CSO Rack 10 and 11) through a construction manager at risk; and declaring an emergency.
