**PLANNING:**

1. Ordinance approving the donation of 158 Lake Street to Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
2. Ordinance approving the sale of City-owned land located at 40 and 42 N. Summit Street; finding that the land is not needed for public purpose; and declaring an emergency.

6. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and/or legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for certain improvements on US-224; and declaring an emergency.
7. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and/or legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for certain improvements on State Routes 18 and 261; and declaring an emergency.
