New Legislation List – September 17, 2018

PLANNING

1. RESOLUTION approving the application of Stephen and Janice Brown to have agricultural property on Diagonal Road to be included in an “agricultural district” pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01, *et seq.*; and declaring an emergency. (Up for Public Hearing 9/17/18)
2. ORDINANCE approving the Home Avenue Redevelopment Plan; making necessary findings in connection therewith; and declaring an emergency. (Up for Public Hearing 9/17/18)
3. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a medical marijuana dispensary at 737 E. North Street; and declaring an emergency. (Up for Public Hearing 9/24/18)
4. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a mixed use residential and retail development at the northwest corner of the intersection of South Hawkins Avenue and Alden Avenue; and declaring an emergency. (Up for Public Hearing 10/1/18)
5. ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a solid fence within the setback at 983 Jean Avenue; and declaring an emergency. (Up for Public Hearing 10/1/18)
6. ORDINANCE approving the sale of city owned land to Akron Zoological Park; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
7. ORDINANCE approving the sale of a certain vacant City-owned property located on Kenmore Boulevard pursuant to the City’s “A Lot for A Little” Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property and to reduce the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.
- 7A. ORDINANCE approving the site plan for Signet Jewelers, Inc., to install a parking lot at 375 Ghent Road; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE

8. ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to apply for, and enter into grant agreement, if awarded, with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the Akron Fulton Airport Runway 7-25 Rehabilitation Project; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC UTILITIES

9. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to adopt the Natural Gas Aggregation Program Plan of Operation and Governance and enter into agreements required for services related to the natural gas aggregation program; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing 9/17/18 and 9/24/18)
10. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee, to enter into an agreement with Buckeye Energy Brokers, Inc., for aggregation consulting services and any other required services related to

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the natural gas aggregation program for the City of Akron and ratifying any such services performed; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SAFETY:

11. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and accept, if awarded, grant funds from the Ohio Department of Public Safety to be used for the continuation and/or implementation of the Impaired Driving Enforcement Program (IDEP) and/or the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP); and declaring an emergency.
12. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into agreements with various political subdivisions for the provision of Contraband Disposal Services; approving the form thereof; and declaring an emergency.

HEALTH & SOCIAL SERVICE:

13. ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee, on behalf of the Akron Municipal Court, to enter into a contract or contracts with the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction & Mental Health Services Board in order to provide funding for certain specialized dockets/programs that manage addicted offenders in the community; and declaring an emergency.
