**BUDGET & FINANCE**

- 1        ORDINANCE accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission of Summit County and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the Summit County Fiscal Officer; and declared an emergency.
  
- 2        RESOLUTION requesting that the Summit County Fiscal Officer make an advanced payment of tax funds for tax year 2018 payable in 2019 to the City of Akron Treasury Division; and declaring an emergency.
  
- 3        ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$3,500,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to retire notes issued for the purpose of providing funds to pay expenses associated with the settlement of health care claims, whether by reserve or otherwise, and the City's portion of the costs of maintaining its self-insurance program for employee health care benefits; and declaring an emergency.
  
- 4        ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$30,000,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to retire notes issued for the purpose of providing funds to pay the costs of various improvements in the City; and declaring an emergency.
  
- 5        ORDINANCE providing for the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$498,412.45 of bonds, to pay, in anticipation of the collection of special assessments heretofore levied, the property owners' portion of the cost of improving certain streets in the City; and declaring an emergency.
  
- 6        ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$5,950,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of constructing, reconstructing, and otherwise improving certain streets in the City; and declaring an emergency.

- 7 ORDINANCE providing for the issuance and sale of notes in a principal amount not exceeding \$13,500,000 to pay the property owners' portion, in anticipation of the levy and collection of special assessments, of the cost of improving certain streets in the City, between certain termini, by providing street-cleaning services and street lighting; and declaring an emergency.
- 8 ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$600,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of improving the municipal parks and recreational system in the City; and declaring an emergency.
- 9 ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$1,000,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of improving municipal buildings and facilities in the City by constructing, reconstructing, renovating, repairing roofs, remodeling, relocating, making site and other improvements, planning and designing facilities and acquiring and installing related equipment, all as applicable, designated or to be designated by the Director of Public Services; and declaring an emergency.
- 10 ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$1,900,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of acquiring and equipping motor vehicles for certain Divisions in the City; and declaring an emergency.
- 11 ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$550,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of certain economic development projects in the City; and declaring an emergency.
- 12 ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$1,300,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to pay the costs of the City's portion of the consolidated Computer Aided Dispatch system being purchased by Summit County in connection with dispatch services for the City's safety forces; and declaring an emergency.
- 13 ORDINANCE providing for the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$1,911,180.55 of bonds, to pay, in anticipation of the collection of special assessments heretofore levied, the property owners' portion of the cost of improving certain streets in the City; and declaring an emergency.

#### PLANNING

- 14 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to install a digital

billboard along I-77 at 530 Nome Avenue; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing scheduled for 10/15)

- 15 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a storage building at 2822 Albrecht Avenue, involving both Albrecht Avenue and Alpha Avenue; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing scheduled for 10/15)
- 16 ORDINANCE amending/supplementing Title 15 “Land Usage”, Chapter 153 “Zoning Code”, Section 153.140 “Definitions” by defining supportive housing and Section 153.305(F) “Private Parking for Residence Occupants” by revising the amount of required off-street residential parking requirements; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing scheduled for 10/15)
- 17 ORDINANCE accepting a vacation plat for a portion of Wheeler Lane, north of East Market Street and authorizing the President of Council and the Clerk of Council to endorse the acceptance by Council; and declaring an emergency.

#### PUBLIC SERVICE

- 18 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the resurfacing of State Route 91, State Route 224, and Canton Road (PID 89113); declaring said project to be in the public interest; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency.

#### PUBLIC UTILITIES

- 19 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase of sodium hypochlorite for disinfection at the Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency.

#### PUBLIC SAFETY

- 20 ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts, with Applied Concepts, Inc. for the purchase of ten (10) Stalker II Moving Radars; and declaring an emergency.

#### HEALTH & SOCIAL SERVICE

- 21 RESOLUTION expressing support for the Summit County Child Services’ levy on the November 6, 2018 ballot and authorizing Summit County Children Services to use the name of the Council for the City of Akron for advertisements and general publicity purposes related to the levy campaign; and declaring an emergency

GREEN/SUSTAINABILITY

- 22 RESOLUTION expressing support for West Creek Conservancy's Clean Ohio Greenspace grant application by the City of Akron to create a Mud Brook Headwaters Conservation Area; and declaring an emergency.
