ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 1, 2018

- 1 RESOLUTION 328-2018 approving and confirming the re-appointment by Mayor Horrigan of GinaKaye Maddox as a member of the Akron Civil Rights Commission; approving and confirming the re-appointment by Mayor Horrigan of John Alvarez Turner as an alternate member of the Akron Civil Rights Commission; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 2 ORDINANCE No. 329-2018 authorizing the issuance of a bond of the City in a principal amount not to exceed \$8,500,000 for sale to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund of the State of Ohio to finance the costs of improvements to the City's wastewater system; pledging certain revenues from the City's wastewater system on a subordinated basis to secure the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bond; and authorizing the execution and delivery of the Bond, the Trust Agreement and other documents and the taking of other actions related to the issuance and sale of the Bond; and declaring an emergency. (Sanitary Sewer Reconstruction 2017) Vote: 12-0
- 3 ORDINANCE No. 330-2018 authorizing the issuance of a bond of the City in a principal amount not to exceed \$3,500,000 for sale to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund of the State of Ohio to finance the costs of improvements to the City's wastewater system; pledging certain revenues from the City's wastewater system on a subordinated basis to secure the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bond; and authorizing the execution and delivery of the Bond, the Trust Agreement and other documents and the taking of other actions related to the issuance and sale of the Bond; and declaring an emergency. (Kelly Conveyance (CSO Rack 3)) Vote: 12-0
- 4 ORDINANCE No. 331-2018 authorizing the issuance of a bond of the City in a principal amount not to exceed \$3,500,000 for sale to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund of the State of Ohio to finance the costs of improvements to the City's wastewater system; pledging certain revenues from the City's wastewater system on a subordinated basis to secure the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bond; and authorizing the execution and delivery of the Bond, the Trust Agreement and other documents and the taking of other actions related to the issuance and

sale of the Bond; and declaring an emergency. (Chittenden Green Project (CSO Rack 3)) Vote: 12-0

- 5 ORDINANCE No. 332-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to purchase up to 30 Lenovo mobile-tablet-personal computers with operating software and maintenance and protection plans from Lenovo Government for use by Water Distribution field personnel; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 6 ORDINANCE No. 333-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a solid fence within the setback at 983 Jean Avenue; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 7 RESOLUTION No. 334-2018 expressing support for the Summit County Child Services' levy on the November 6, 2018 ballot and authorizing Summit County Children Services to use the name of the Council for the City of Akron for advertisements and general publicity purposes related to the levy campaign; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 8 ORDINANCE No. 335-2018 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$3,500,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to retire notes issued for the purpose of providing funds to pay expenses associated with the settlement of health care claims, whether by reserve or otherwise, and the City's portion of the costs of maintaining its self-insurance program for employee health care benefits; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
- 9 RESOLUTION No. 336-2018 expressing support for West Creek Conservancy's Clean Ohio Greenspace grant application by the City of Akron to create a Mud Brook Headwaters Conservation Area; and declaring an emergency. Vote: 12-0
