ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 22, 2018

- 1 ORD 355-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts, with Applied Concepts, Inc. for the purchase of ten (10) Stalker II Moving Radars; and declaring an emergency. (Substitute offered as an amendment) VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)
- 2 RES 356-2018 approving and confirming the re-appointment of Bruce Bolden to the City Board of Zoning Appeals; approving and confirming the appointments of Candice Eberhardt, Perry Clark, and Sara Avalos to the City Board of Zoning Appeals; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)
- 3 ORD 357-2018 approving the sale of vacant City-owned properties pursuant to the City's "A Lot for A Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of property and to reduce the cost to the City and the taxpayers in maintaining vacant lots; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)
- 4 ORD 358-2018 approving the sale of city owned land to D&P of Ohio Partnership and Braymor Development, LLC; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)
- 5 ORD 359-2018 approving the donation of city owned land to the Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)

- 9 ORD 363-2018 authorizing the transfer of city owned property on Sumner and Allyn Streets to Akron Public Schools in exchange for property owned by Akron Public Schools on Dayton Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)
- 10 RES 364-2018 approving and confirming the re-appointments of David Hawkins and Charlie Ryder to the Urban Design and Historic Preservation Commission; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)
- 11 ORD 365-2018 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Liberta Construction for the emergency repair of the trunk sewer located near the intersection of Mull Avenue and Exchange Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)
- 12 ORD 366-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Kustom Signals, Inc. for the purchase of ten (10) ProLaser 4 bundles for use by the City of Akron Police Department; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)
- 13 ORD 367-2018 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to accept an Assistance to Firefighters Grant from the Department of Homeland Security for the purchase of a new fire-related vehicle; authorizing the expenditure of local matching funds from the appropriate account or accounts; authorizing the purchase of said vehicle after publicly advertising for bids; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)
- 14 ORD 368-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for and accept, if awarded, grant funds from the Northern Ohio Golf Charities Foundation for repairs and additions to facilities at Hardesty Park; and declaring and emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)

- 15 ORD 369-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the redesign, repair, update, addition and/or improvement of grounds, equipment, and facilities/fixtures at certain City of Akron Parks in keeping with the Akron Parks Challenge; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)
- 16 RES 370-2018 approving and confirming the re-appointment of Michael Dobbertin to the Housing Appeals Board; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)
- 17 ORD 371-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept \$250,000 in grant funds through the Summit County Transportation Improvement District, awarded by the Ohio Department of Transportation's Office of Jobs and Commerce, for the improvement of the Firestone Business Park; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)
- 18 ORD 372-2018 amending Ordinance No. 82-2018, passed March 19, 2018, which established the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2018; and declared an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 19 RES 373-2018 expressing support for alternative pathways to graduation in Ohio; urging the Ohio General Assembly to extend alternative pathways to graduation to the classes of 2019 and beyond; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 20 ORD 374-2018 approving the expenditure of additional funds for the 2018 Akron Neighborhood Maintenance and Empowerment Program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 21 ORD 375-2018 accepting a vacation plat and rededication plat as utility right of way for Firestone Parkway, Firestone Plaza, Gottwalt Street and Cole Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-0 (Freeman absent) (Kammer abstained)
- 22 ORD 376-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of one breathing air compressor to be used at the Akron Fire Division Maintenance Facility; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
