ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 29, 2018

- 1 ORD 377-2018 authorizing the issuance of a bond of the City in a principal amount not to exceed \$6,000,000 for sale to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund of the State of Ohio to finance the costs of improvements to the City's wastewater system; pledging certain revenues from the City's wastewater system on a subordinated basis to secure the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bond; and authorizing the execution and delivery of the Bond, the Trust Agreement and other documents and the taking of other actions related to the issuance and sale of the Bond; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 2 ORD 378-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a mixed use residential and retail development at the northwest corner of the intersection of South Hawkins Avenue and Alden Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 3 ORD 379-2018 repealing Title 11, Chapter 110, "Business Regulations," Section 110.31, "Polygraph Tests" of the Akron Codified Ordinances; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 4 ORD 380-2018 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept \$25,000 in grant funds through the Better Future platform, awarded by Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, for promoting safe mobility, inspiring students to reach their full potential, and reducing environmental impact; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 5 ORD 381-2018 amending and supplementing Title 3, "Administration," Chapter 38, "Unlawful Discrimination," of the Akron Codified Ordinances; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 6 RES 382-2018 approving and confirming the appointment by Mayor Horrigan of Scott Rowland, Lauren Alexander, Greg Burke, Ellis W. Polk, and Renee M. Nied to the Vacant Commercial or Industrial Building Appeals Board; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 7 ORD 383-2018 approving the expenditure of additional funds for mowing of publicly-owned and privately-owned lots; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 8 ORD 384-2018 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, after advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the remodeling of the Patrol Office Rm #511; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 9 ORD 385-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with S.A. Comunale Company, Inc. for the emergency repair and replacement of the fire sprinkler system in Morley Parking Deck; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
