BUDGET & FINANCE

- 1 ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 82-2018, passed March 19, 2018, and Ordinance No. 372-2018, passed October 22, 2018, which established the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2018; and declaring an emergency.

- 2 ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance of a bond of the City in a principal amount not to exceed \$34,500,000 for sale to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund of the State of Ohio to finance the costs of improvements to the City’s wastewater system; pledging certain revenues from the City’s wastewater system on a subordinated basis to secure the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bond; and authorizing the execution and delivery of the Bond, the Trust Agreement and other documents and the taking of other actions related to the issuance and sale of the Bond; and declaring an emergency.

- 3 ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance of a bond of the City in a principal amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 for sale to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund of the State of Ohio to finance the costs of improvements to the City’s wastewater system; pledging certain revenues from the City’s wastewater system on a subordinated basis to secure the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bond; and authorizing the execution and delivery of the Bond, the Trust Agreement and other documents and the taking of other actions related to the issuance and sale of the Bond; and declaring an emergency.

- 4 ORDINANCE approving and authorizing the expenditure of \$8,500 previously designated for the Akron City Council travel budget for the purchase of one-year subscriptions of the Balancing Act PRO, Taxpayer Receipt, and Meeting Mode software as approved in Ordinance No. 100-2018; and declaring an emergency.

- 10 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a child day care business center at 716 City View Avenue; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing Scheduled for 12/17/18)
- 11 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to establish an aesthetician (skin care) office at 2029 West Market Street; and declaring an emergency. (Public Hearing Scheduled for 12/17/18)
- 12 ORDINANCE authorizing the purchase of vacant lots on 5th Avenue, Arden Place, Chittenden Street, Duane Avenue, Kelly Avenue, and Talbot Avenue for the CSO Rack 3 (Kelly Green) Project; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE

- 13 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the Hampton Ridge Sanitary Sewer; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency.

- 14 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of a replacement for the Sourek Road Pump Station; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency.
- 15 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to file applications and enter into agreements with the Ohio EPA and Ohio Water Development Authority for a Water Pollution Control Loan to fund the construction of the Sourek Road Pump Station Replacement Project; and declaring an emergency.
- 16 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to file applications and enter into agreements with the Ohio EPA and Ohio Water Development Authority for a 20-year Water Pollution Control Loan to fund the Sanitary Sewer Reconstruction 2014 Phase I Project; and declaring an emergency.
- 17 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to file applications and enter into agreements with the Ohio EPA and Ohio Water Development Authority for a 30-year Water Pollution Control Loan to fund the Sanitary Sewer Reconstruction 2016 Project; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- 18 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Law to enter into a contract with the Summit County Public Defender Commission to provide legal services for indigent defendants in Akron Municipal Court, in accordance with the requirements of the Constitution of the United States with respect to the provision of legal representation to indigent defendants; and declaring an emergency.
- 19 ORDINANCE ratifying the application for funding from the Ohio Attorney General's Law Enforcement Body Armor Program; and authorizing the Mayor to accept the grant from the Ohio Attorney General's Law Enforcement Body Armor Program to enable the Akron Police Department to procure lifesaving body armor; and declaring an emergency.
- 20 ORDINANCE ratifying the application for funding from COPS Office School Violence Prevention Program (SVPP) administered by the U.S. Department of Justice; and authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept funding from the SVPP to purchase safety equipment identified as needed for Akron Public Schools and resource officers that serve them; and declaring an emergency.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & JOB CREATION

- 21 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to enter into a grant agreement with Beyond Expectations Barber College, LLC in the amount of Thirty-Two Thousand Five-Hundred Dollars (\$32,500) for operating, personnel or other expenses; and declaring an emergency.

- 22 RESOLUTION endorsing and authorizing the termination of the Revolving Loan Fund Plan Certification as required by the U.S. Economic Development Administration; and declaring an emergency.
