ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED DECEMBER 10, 2018

- 1 ORD 412-2018 authorizing the issuance of a bond of the City in a principal amount not to exceed \$34,500,000 for sale to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund of the State of Ohio to finance the costs of improvements to the City's wastewater system; pledging certain revenues from the City's wastewater system on a subordinated basis to secure the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bond; and authorizing the execution and delivery of the Bond, the Trust Agreement and other documents and the taking of other actions related to the issuance and sale of the Bond; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)

- 2 ORD 413-2018 authorizing the issuance of a bond of the City in a principal amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 for sale to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund of the State of Ohio to finance the costs of improvements to the City's wastewater system; pledging certain revenues from the City's wastewater system on a subordinated basis to secure the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bond; and authorizing the execution and delivery of the Bond, the Trust Agreement and other documents and the taking of other actions related to the issuance and sale of the Bond; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)

- 3 ORD 414-2018 authorizing the purchase of vacant lots on 5th Avenue, Arden Place, Chittenden Street, Duane Avenue, Kelly Avenue, and Talbot Avenue for the CSO Rack 3 (Kelly Green) Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)

- 4 ORD 415-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the Hampton Ridge Sanitary Sewer; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)

- 5 ORD 416-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of a replacement for the Sourek Road Pump Station; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 6 ORD 417-2018 authorizing the Mayor to file applications and enter into agreements with the Ohio EPA and Ohio Water Development Authority for a Water Pollution Control Loan to fund the construction of the Sourek Road Pump Station Replacement Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 7 ORD 418-2018 authorizing the Mayor to file applications and enter into agreements with the Ohio EPA and Ohio Water Development Authority for a 20-year Water Pollution Control Loan to fund the Sanitary Sewer Reconstruction 2014 Phase I Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 8 ORD 419-2018 authorizing the Mayor to file applications and enter into agreements with the Ohio EPA and Ohio Water Development Authority for a 30-year Water Pollution Control Loan to fund the Sanitary Sewer Reconstruction 2016 Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 9 ORD 420-2018 authorizing the Director of Law to enter into a contract with the Summit County Public Defender Commission to provide legal services for indigent defendants in Akron Municipal Court, in accordance with the requirements of the Constitution of the United States with respect to the provision of legal representation to indigent defendants; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 10 ORD 421-2018 ratifying the application for funding from the Ohio Attorney General's Law Enforcement Body Armor Program; and authorizing the Mayor to accept the grant from the Ohio Attorney General's Law Enforcement Body Armor Program to enable the Akron Police Department to procure lifesaving body armor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 11 ORD 422-2018 ratifying the application for funding from COPS Office School Violence Prevention Program (SVPP) administered by the U.S. Department of Justice; and authorizing the Mayor or his designee to accept funding from the SVPP to purchase safety equipment identified as needed for Akron Public Schools and resource officers that serve them; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)

- 12 ORD 423-2018 endorsing and authorizing the termination of the Revolving Loan Fund Plan Certification as required by the U.S. Economic Development Administration; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 13 ORD 424-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish an auto repair business at 248 Cole Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 14 ORD 425-2018 authorizing a Conditional Use to park a commercial box truck at 1156 Reed Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 10-2 (Hoch, Kammer) (Freeman absent)
- 15 ORD 426-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into forestry management-related agreements affecting the Upper Cuyahoga River Watershed; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
- 16 ORD 427-2018 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a right to use agreement between the City of Akron and the City of Fairlawn for the use of Akron-owned fiber-optic cable; finding that the subject fiber is not currently needed for municipal purposes; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman absent)
