### ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED JANUARY 7, 2019

- 1 ORD 1-2019 enacting Title 3 “Administration,” Article 3 “Appeals,” Section 31.99 “Appeals” of the Akron Code of Ordinances to explicitly authorize the Mayor or his designee to appeal the adverse decision of an administrative body; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 2 ORD 2-2019 approving the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District Petition and the Services Plan to be provided by the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District, Inc.; and declaring an emergency. (VOTE 13-0)
- 3 ORD 3-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of a 700 GPM grease pump for the Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency. (VOTE 13-0)
- 4 ORD 4-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the installation of water mains on Druid Drive, Hammond Boulevard, Raleigh Boulevard, Schoolcraft Avenue, and Cleveland-Massillon Road as a part of the Druid Drive Neighborhood Water Main Extension Regionalization Project; and declaring an emergency. (VOTE 13-0)
- 5 ORD 5-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, to enter into a contract or contracts, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, for up to a three-year maintenance agreement with Itron for the testing, repair and replacement of existing handheld AMR meter reading field collector units; and declaring an emergency. (VOTE 13-0)
- 6 ORD 6-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into an agreement with the City of Hudson to define the cost sharing responsibilities in the restoration of Middleton Road; authorizing compensation/reimbursement to the City of Hudson in accordance with such agreement; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 7 RES 7-2019 approving the renewal application of Evelia Maldonado Ramos to have agricultural property at 1080 St. Michaels Avenue placed in an “agricultural district” pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01. VOTE 13-0
- 8 RES 8-2019 approving the renewal application of Donald and Carol Bessemer to have agricultural property at 1456 St. Michaels Avenue and 1543 Collier Road placed in an “agricultural district” pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01. VOTE 13-0
- 9 ORD 9-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a group home at 85 Kent Place; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Kammer abstained)
- 10 ORD 10-2019 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into a lease agreement with the Genesis Outdoor Advertising to lease City-owned land at 530 Nome Avenue to install and maintain a digital billboard; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 11 ORD 11-2019 authorizing the Mayor to execute an option agreement and related agreements with Shin-Etsu Silicones of America, Inc., for the sale of 41.85 acres of City-owned land; determining the property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 12 ORD 12-2019 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into a lease agreement with Congresswoman Marcia L. Fudge, United States House of Representatives, 11th District of Ohio, for offices at the Lawton Community Center of the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 13 ORD 13-2019 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract or contracts, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, with Phoenix Safety Outfitters for the purchase of ladder/escape belts for use by the Akron Fire Division; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
