ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 4, 2019

1. ORD 55-2019 approving the sale of vacant City-owned property pursuant to the City's "A Lot for a Little" Program, in order to facilitate the productive re-use of the property; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
2. ORD 56-2019 accepting a dedication plat for a portion of Harmon Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
3. ORD 57-2019 approving the donation of 983 Stadelman Avenue to Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
4. RES 58-2019 declaring it necessary to improve North Main Street between the termini of State Route 59 and Market Street and South Main Street between the termini of Market Street and Mill Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches and utility vaults; installing street lighting and planting trees; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
5. RES 59-2019 declaring it necessary to improve Tallmadge Avenue between the termini of North Main Street and Gorge Boulevard by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes and planting trees; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
6. ORD 60-2019 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into an agreement, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, with Brite Computers for the renewal of NetMotion software and/or related services; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
7. ORD 61-2019 declaring certain improvements to real property located in the Ascot Urban Redevelopment Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation; providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes and the deposit of

those service payments in the appropriate fund; providing for the payment of a portion of the service payments to the Woodridge Local School District, all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the "Act"); and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

8. RES 62-2019 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2019 Phase I Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
9. RES 63-2019 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2019 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface, and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Freeman abstained)
10. RES 64-2019 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2019 Phase I Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
11. RES 65-2019 acknowledging the accomplishments and career of James Ingram; expressing condolences and sympathy to the family of James Ingram on his passing; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
